Remarks Monday Nov the 1 1841
first part light breeze running
in for the land middle part
shortened sail at 7 wore ship and
stood off until 11 then wore and
layed with the main gear aback
latter part at daylight made sail
and ran in at 3 shortened sail and
stood off sailing about 40 miles
from 12 point bearing SNE
50 ends

Remarks Tuesday Nov the 2 1841

first part sailing and squally again
all round the compass at 2 took
in all sail at 3 made some
sail light breeze from N headed
off and on at sunset 18 point
of land bearing SNE 20 Miles
Dist Middle part strong gales from
NW 8 1/2 and clear light to be seen off
latter part at 5 more moderate
wore ship made sail and headed
in for land 10 ends
Lat 43 28 10 S

Remarks Wednesday Nov the 3 1841

first part strong breeze at 9 at 3
hove aback of the port lowered at
bunt Capt went on shore at 10 part
4 came off to sagged to get off potatoes
squashed off and run round to leeward
for the night middle part strong ga-
les and squally at 3 rather more
moderate made sail latter part
ran into the port at 8 Capt went
on shore at 11 took off in the
lighter 80 lbs of potatoes etc
recovered off and stored 1 quint
from 10 ends
