first part light breeze all hands employed in ships duty saw 8 sail caught 10 porpoise middle part light breeze latter part the same all hands employed in ships duty 10 ends

Remarks Sunday Nov the 16 1841

first part light breeze all hands employed in ships duty at 9 saw a school of sperm whales at 11 part of lumber and position at 2 whales got 2 boats stove and saved 1 small whale at took him along side middle part got ready part cutting latter part got cut in at 4 all hands employed chasing up and repairing the mast 10 ends

Remarks On Monday Nov the 17 1841

first part good weather all hands employed in putting boats out 6 pushed the boats middle part rain and wind blowing run under short sail latter part at daylight saw 8 sails my began to hoist at 9 saw a school of sperm whales going quick in for the land lowered and chased could not catch one 10 ends

first part light breeze from NW 8 heads 18 in for the land at 9 saw 8 whales and lowered fastened with the harbor boat and dower at sunset hoisted up and finished rigging middle part large black latter part standing to the Northward watch employed in ships duty 10 ends
