sails and took in the furl
at 3 let out the reefs and set
the topgallant sails saw a great
number of porpoises Middle part
strong breeze latter part the same
at 8 saw Staten land at 11 saw
a bark at Mesurau within
9 miles of the eastern point so
ends. Lat 45° 42' S
Observed about right
