first part mild variable and squally at 6 wind came quiet to S in a squall took in foretopmast fore sail and mainsail and close reefed the main track in the main and heaved 1/2 Middle part strong gales and squally at 12 set the foresail and mizen topsail latter part made more sail 30 miles
