

Remarks On board Ship Martha Fairhaven August 20 1842

Sunday August the 21 1842

first part sent one boat beginning got 4 boys coconuts & at 5 came off middle part laying off and on latter part got 2 boys so ends

Monday August the 22 1842

first part good weather began off and on brought one pig at 6 the trader came on board with his wife put away for Dominica middle part run down for Dominica steered N 20 in between Dominica and Sticks at went ashore to Dominica with the trader so ends

Tuesday August the 23 1842

first part light air and happing at 4 boat came off with 8 pigs and 22 small pumpkins and the lips of 2 oys stolen middle part sun 2 1/2 W under easy sail latter part at 2 have aboard off upon and evening with one boat trading at Sticks came off with 8 boys so ends

Wednesday August the 24 1842

first part trader and fine weather laying off and on one boat went in and got 3 boys at 5 kept off N 1/2 W middle part steered N latter part steered N watch employed in ships duty so ends

Thursday August the 25 1842

first fine breeze from E 1/4 N steered N watch employed in ships duty middle part steered N 1/2 W latter by the wind N 1/2 E so ends

Friday August the 26 1842

first part strong breeze from E at 5 took in flying topgallant sails and one reef in the fore topsail middle part strong breeze and squally single reefed the main and fore top sails latter strong breeze from E 1/2 E heard N 1/2 E watch employed in ships duty so ends

Remarks On board Ship Martha Fairhaven August 27 1842

Saturday August the 28 1842

first part strong breeze heard N 1/2 W watch employed fitting blocks & middle part squally shortened sail heard N 1/2 E latter part strong breeze made more sail so ends

Sunday August the 28 1842

first part strong breeze from E heard N 1/2 E watch employed in ships duty middle part strong breeze latter part the same at 8 saw 2 whales going to windward lowered 2 boats but could not catch when John Kelly and Michael gone got to fight in tiger then together and let them have it so ends

any more as knife and threatened to kill the first man that came Monday August the 29 1842

Long Chron 14 1 8 W

first part strong breeze from E heard N 1/2 E middle part squally latter part the same watch employed in ships duty so ends

Latt Obs 1 5-4 S
Long Chron 14 10 W

Tuesday August the 30 1842

first part strong breeze from E 1/4 N heard N 1/2 E middle part the same latter part heard N 1/2 E watch employed in ships duty so ends

Latt Obs 00 55 S
Long Chron 14 0 56 W

Wednesday August the 31 1842

first part strong breeze from E 1/4 S heard N 1/2 E watch employed in ships duty middle part those moderate latter part the same saw finbacks and cow fish so ends

Latt Obs 00 8 N
Long Chron 14 0 5-4 W

Thursday Sept the 1 1842

first part more moderate sent down the main topgallant and put on a new cross tree sent it up again middle part made all sail at daylight tacked ship latter part repairing an old boat so ends

Latt Obs 00 25 N

Friday August the 2 1842 first part good weather wind fresh E 1/2 E heard S watch employed in ships duty middle part the same latter part strong breeze heard S 1/2 E so ends

Latt Obs 1 25 S
Long Chron 14 1 33 W
