

Remarks on board Ship Martha Fairhaven Dec 11 1842

Sunday Dec the 11 1842

first part wind from E N E headed
S E westerly employed in ship's duty gave a pin-bark
middle part thunder and rain with light variable
wind back in all sail but double reefed Main topsail
and fore sail at 4 made all sail latter part wind light
and variable so ends
Lat 41° 38' N
Long 148° 15' W

Monday Dec the 12 1842

first part light breeze from N E
headed E S E middle part squally and light breeze
and variable latter part the same wind Lat 41° 50' N
Long 148° 12' W

Tuesday Dec the 13 1842

first part wind light from
N E by N and cloudy headed E by S westerly employed
in ship's duty middle part light winds and variable
with rain headed E by N latter rain light variable wind
from S to N W so ends
Lat 41° 50' N
Long 148° 12' W

Wednesday Dec the 14 1842

first part wind from N E by E
light rain at 10 o'clock slowly steered N E middle
part strong breeze and squally from N E by E steered
E by N double reefed the fore and main topsails and
took in the Main latter part wind strong
from N W shook one reef out of the Main
topsail and set single reefed Mizen steered E by
S so ends
Lat 41° 50' N
Long 148° 00' W

Thursday Dec the 15 1842

first part strong breeze from
N E by E steered S E rigger took in the Main
topsail middle part very squally at 9 took in all sail at
10 set close reefed Main topsail latter part moderate made
all sail steady E N E so ends
Lat 41° 50' N
Long 148° 00' W

Friday Dec the 16 1842

first part wind from N E by E
and good weather steered E N E middle part squally
shortened sail latter part wind from N E by E made
all sail so ends
Lat 41° 50' N
Long 148° 00' W

Remarks on board Ship Martha Fairhaven Dec 17 1842

Saturday Dec the 17 1842

first part strong breeze from N W steered
E at 6 shortened sail ~~steered~~ Main topsail
and sail and Main topsail steering sail middle
part made all sail latter part light breeze from N E and
good weather so ends
Lat 41° 50' N
Long 148° 12' W

Sunday Dec the 18 1842

first part squally and raining took
in spring sails and double reefed the fore topsail
single reefed the Main middle part light air and
calm with rain latter wind from N E by N steered
E by N all sail so ends
Lat 41° 50' N
Long 148° 00' W

Monday Dec the 19 1842

first part wind from N N W
and fine weather steered E N E middle part
wind from N N headed E latter part the same
went up fore topsail and good weather so ends
Lat 41° 50' N
Long 148° 12' W

Tuesday Dec the 20 1842

first part wind from N E by E
steered E by N Mizen top sail took in middle part
light breeze headed E by S latter part light breeze
from N E headed E S all hands employed breaking
out in the fore hold and stowing up so ends
Lat 41° 50' N
Long 148° 00' W

Wednesday Dec the 21 1842

first part light breeze from
N E headed E S finished stowing and washed off
deck the part light breeze latter part the same headed
E by S so ends
Lat 41° 50' N
Long 148° 12' W

Thursday Dec the 22 1842

first part light breeze from E by N
headed E by S mending topsail middle part calm
and light baffling air latter part calm calked
in and on the quarter decks and setting
up rigging so ends
Lat 41° 50' N
Long 148° 00' W
