

Remarks On board Ship Martha Fairhaven June 10 1849
Saturday June the 12 1849

first part wind light from NW
at 1 saw Whales at 1/2 past 1 lowered at 4 went
along side of a Whale with the Larboard bow
and missed him at 6 came on board Middle
part steered 1/2 W under easy sail latter part at 8
saw Whales going quick to windward lowered
but did not get on wind from 8 saw a great
many pinbacks so ends
Lat 42° 52' N
Long 71° 45' W

Sunday June the 13 1849
first part light breeze from
SE at 6 saw Whales lowered but going quick
and with at 7 hoisted up Middle light headed
s until 12 hoisted up to NW at 2 more ship
and steered E latter part steered NW at 4 saw
Whales at 5/2 lowered two boats struck
one with the Starboard boat so ends
Lat 42° 42' N
Long 71° 45' W

Monday June the 14 1849
first part wind NE at 2
hook the Whales along side and run off for three
Whales lowered but did not get on at 1/2 past 4
began to cut at 6 got him all in Middle part
long under short sail, headed E 1/2 S latter part strong
breeze from NW headed SE at 4 began to hoist
at 11 saw Whales going quick to windward lowered
two boats did not come up with them so ends Lat 42° 10' N
Long 71° 15' W

Tuesday June the 20 1849
first part strong breeze from
SE headed 1/2 W hooking saw a back to windward
cutting Middle part regularly latter part wind from
SE headed SE 1/2 W weather sunny
Lat 42° 10' N
Long 71° 48' W

Wednesday June the 21 1849 first part light breeze
from NW headed S Middle part at 9 finished hoisting
latter part wind light from NW headed SE 1/2 W
saw a sail so ends
Lat 42° 55' N
Long 71° 55' W

Thursday June the 22 1849

first part light breeze from NW
at 5 spoke the Whales got up Carter Middle part
light breeze headed to the SE latter part wind from SE headed SE 1/2 W
saw two sail so ends
Lat 42° 30' N
Long 71° 40' W

Friday June the 23 1849
first part wind from SE headed
at 6 spoke the Whales got up Middle part
light breeze headed to the SE latter part strong
breeze from SE headed SE 1/2 W saw two sail and a num-
ber of pinbacks so ends
Lat 42° 50' N
Long 71° 45' W

Saturday June the 24 1849
first part strong breeze from NW
headed 1/2 W set down the bit in the Chubroom
Middle part headed SE latter part headed SE 1/2 W
wind strong from NW 1/2 S so ends
Lat 42° 11' N
Long 71° 13' E

Sunday June the 25 1849
first part strong breeze from
NW headed SE 1/2 S same as first to windward
saw blackfish the SE part headed SE 1/2 S latter
part the same saw a sail so ends
Lat 42° 19' N
Long 71° 11' E

Monday June the 26 1849
first part wind from NW 1/2 S
headed NW 1/2 N Middle part the same latter part
regularly in the morning at 9 feared off headed
N saw two sail so ends
Lat 42° 50' N

Tuesday June the 27 1849
first part wind from NW 1/2 S headed
at 1 spoke the New Bedford 38 months 1400 Middle
part headed SE 1/2 S latter part strong breeze from
NW headed NW 1/2 W under double reef saw a
sail to windward so ends
Lat 42° 19' N
Long 71° 50' E

Wednesday June the 28 1849 first part strong breeze from NW
headed NW 1/2 W saw two sail at night shortened sail Middle
part strong breeze short sail latter part the same
saw pinbacks so ends
Lat 42° 50' N
Long 71° 20' E
