

Remarks On board Ship *Mattha Fairhaven* July 23^d 1849

Sunday July the 23^d 1849

first part strong gales from E headed N.W. saw a sail, middle part the same latter part more moderate made sail so ends
Latt Obs 30 " 32 N

Monday July the 24th 1849

first part wind from E headed S.W. saw a sail, middle part the same latter part from E.W. headed N saw a sail but no whales so ends
Latt Obs 30 " 1. N
Long Chron 169 " 3 E

Tuesday July the 25th 1849

first part wind from S.W. steered S.E. saw porpoises and a hawk, middle part headed S.W. latter part steered W saw a sail and no whales so ends
Latt Obs 29 " 24 N
Long Chron 168 " 54 E

Tuesday July the 26th 1849

first part wind from N.W. steered S.W. at 5 spoke the young *Hera* and three Brothers of Nantucket, middle part headed N.W. latter part headed N.W. & sail in sight so ends
Latt Obs 29 " 38 N

Wednesday July the 27th 1849

first part wind from N.W. headed N.W. saw two sail in sight, middle part light breeze from N.W. latter part the same two sail in sight so ends
Latt Obs 30 " 24 N
Long Chron 168 " 35 E

Thursday July the 28th 1849

first part light breeze from E.W. headed N spoke the sun and coral, middle part calm latter part the same so ends
Latt Obs 30 " 32 N

Friday July the 29th 1849

first part calm and light air headed N.W. the two ships in sight engaged in pointing the stern, middle part light air latter part the same the two ships in sight so ends
Latt Obs 30 " 35 N

Remarks On board Ship *Mattha Fairhaven* August 1st 1849

Saturday July the 30th 1849

first part light breeze from E.W. headed N.E. watch employed in ship, duty saw another gale of bark, middle part wind strong and squally from E.W. headed N.W. shortened sail latter part the same so ends
Latt Obs 31 " 59 N

Monday July the 31st 1849

first part strong breeze and squally from E headed N.W. the sun to windward at 1 took in all but close reefed main topsail and spencers and fore topmast staysail, middle part the same latter part strong gales from S.E. laying to headed S.W. so ends
Latt Obs 32 " 46 N
Long Chron 170 " 12 E

Tuesday August the 1st 1849

first part at 9 wore ship wind from S.W. headed E laying to, middle part more moderate made sail, middle part wind from S.W. latter part made all sail wind from S.W. steered E saw porpoises so ends
Latt Obs 32 " 59 N
Long Chron 171 " 9 E

Wednesday August the 2nd 1849

first part wind from S.W. headed E lowered fore blackpink, struck away and left him saw porpoises, middle part the same latter part headed E saw porpoises so ends
Latt Obs 32 " 55 N

Thursday August the 3rd 1849

first part wind from S headed E.O. took the oil up from between decks and employed coopers in oil saw porpoises and jumpers, middle part headed S.W. latter part the same steering down of 15 in the main hatch way saw porpoises so ends
Latt Obs 32 " 24 N
Long Chron 170 " 50 E
