

Remarks On board Ship Martha Foulshaven Oct 10 1849

Sunday Oct the 15 1849

first part wind light from NW
steered SW land ahead saw two sail vessels
putting blocks to middle part light been shown in
for the land at daylight off keel was bang to the part
at 4 Capt went on shore sent chains to out
in part 11 Capt came on board with the Pilot
residing came to an anchor in five fathoms water
so ends. Manner of Newport and Waverly in part

Monday Oct the 16 1849

first part one watch on liberty
at sunset came off middle part saw latter part
the same sent 120 cask por water on shore the Am
Alexander came in 24 M the 11 so ends

Tuesday Oct the 17 1849

first part got off the raft and
stowed it away and got off another small one
Bulls part the same latter part got off another raft
of water and stowed it down so ends

Wednesday Oct the 18 1849

first part good weather got off
a raft of water and head ship the Division and
by changes came in latter part saw watch on
liberty got off 1 boat load and a half of wood so ends

Thursday Oct the 19 1849

first part saw at sunset watch
came off latter part watch on liberty got off 2 boats
load of wood and stowed it away so ends

Friday Oct the 20 1849

first part blacked the head at night
watch came off latter part another watch on shore
they that ship for the season went on shore so ends
and has not come off again had no discharge so ends

Saturday Oct the 21 1849 first part got off 10 lbs of potatoes
2 kanakars run away at night watch came off latter
part one watch on liberty and the other getting
off wood so ends

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Sunday Oct the 22 1849

first part getting off wood and potatoes
at night by the Higgins only Michael Poor and
Joseph ~~Wade~~ did not come off latter part
half on liberty resters not off so ends

Monday Oct the 23 1849

first part on liberty at night
came off latter part the other half on liberty
caught the two kanakars put them in iron bands
for bananas water melons & latter part the same

Tuesday Oct the 24 1849

first part on liberty latter part the
same got off one boat load of wood so ends

Wednesday Oct the 25 1849

first part got off wood & latter
part variously employed on liberty so ends

Thursday Oct the 26 1849

first part variously employed got
off one watch on liberty latter part the same loaded
2 lbs of blackfish oil & so ends

Friday Oct the 27 1849

first part got off 2 boats load
of potatoes saw on liberty latter part got ready
for sea shipped 9 kanakars so ends

Saturday Oct the 28 1849

first part at 4 pilot came
on board at 6 move up the anchor and dropped
out further ready for getting under weigh in the
morning latter part at 4 got under weigh and stowed
out of the bay at 4 Discharged the Pilot employed stowing
anchors so ends

Sunday Oct the 29 1849 first part wind light from E steered
NW 1/2 W found a man stowing away, a stranger Waverly
in sight middle part light been paid calm steered
NW latter part calm saw two sail so ends
