

Remarks on board Ship Martha Fishaven Jan 1844

Saturday Jan. the 6 1844  
first part wind from NNE stiff  
breeze headed by watch employed in ships duty  
middle part steered W latter part steered SW  
so ends  
Latt Obs 2 5-3 S  
Long Chron 141.55 1/2

Sunday Jan. the 7 1844  
first part wind from NNE  
steered NW took in over halyards and  
employed by watch in the fore part  
the same latter part steered SSE saw nothing  
and not liked to so ends  
Latt Obs 4 3-1  
Long Chron 145.15 1/2

Monday Jan. the 8 1844  
first part wind from NW  
steered SSE middle part the same latter  
part wind from NNW steering SSE employed in  
fitting halyards so ends  
Latt Obs 5-11-1  
Long Chron 147.58 1/2

Tuesday Jan. the 9 1844  
first part wind from NNW  
steered SSE fitting halyards and started  
wrote middle part squally and rain at 9 wind  
shifted in a squall to NW shortened sail latter  
part rain wind from SW so ends  
Latt Obs 6-9-1  
one sight hury

Wednesday Jan. the 10 1844  
first part wind light from  
NW light rain at times, made sail and  
steered SE middle part the same latter part steered  
E by S wind from WNW so ends  
Latt Obs 7-9-1  
Long Chron 142.55 1/2

Thursday Jan. the 11 1844  
first part wind from WNW steered  
E by S watch employed in ships duty middle part  
rain and squally under short sail latter part good  
weather wind from NNE headed E so ends  
Latt Obs 8-5-1  
Long Chron 141.53 1/2

Friday Jan. the 12 1844 first part light breeze from  
NNE headed E at 4 bent another main top sail  
middle part squally and rain latter part wind  
from E by N headed E by S saw a sail on  
purpoiser so ends  
Latt Obs 8-25-1  
Long Chron 140.55 1/2

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Saturday Jan. the 13 1844  
first part wind from E by N headed NNE  
at 3 took in at 1/2 spoke the Ceres of the Wilmington 20 months  
4 days went on board middle part headed SE until 1/2  
then more round latter part wind from NE headed  
NNW sail in sight so ends  
Latt Obs 8-1-1  
Long Chron 141.8 1/2

Sunday Jan. the 14 1844  
first part light breeze from NE  
headed E by N watch employed in the fore part  
on board middle part headed NNW rain under short  
sail latter part light breeze from NE headed NW  
by N lines in sight so ends  
Latt Obs 3-10-1  
Kanaka still sick Long Chron 141.24 1/2

Monday Jan. the 15 1844  
first part light air and calm until  
4 then came out in a squall from W took  
in all sail but spencers and staysail the Ceres  
handy to windward middle part calm latter  
part the same at 8 the Capt went on board  
of the Ceres to get some canvas spliced so  
ends  
Latt Obs 4-26-1  
Long Chron 141.16 1/2

Tuesday Jan. the 16 1844  
first part calm the Ceres in  
company middle part calm latter at 9 wind  
breeze from NE steered NW watch employed in  
ships duty Ceres in company so ends  
Latt Obs 4-25-1  
Long Chron 141.36 1/2

Wednesday Jan. the 17 1844  
first part light breeze from NNE  
steered NW Ceres in sight had still sick middle  
part steered E by N under short sail latter part  
wind from N headed E squally short sail so ends  
Latt Obs 5-20-1

Thursday Jan. the 18 1844  
first part squally from NNE headed  
W by N took in fore and mizen top sails middle  
part wind from NW headed W latter part  
rain headed E by S under short sail so ends  
Latt Obs 4-25-1
