

Remarks On board Ship Martha Fairhaven Jan. 1844

Friday Jan. the 19 1844

first part breeze from N & steered
N by W watch employed in ship's duty at
night shortened sail Middle part steered N by
wind from N and squally latter part strong breeze
from NNE so ends. Lat 6° 56' S
Long 149° 4'

Saturday Jan. the 20 1844

first part strong breeze from NNE
headed N by W at 5 am squally took in
all sail but close reefed main topsail and
spencers Middle part squally laying too headed
from N to NNE latter part the same headed
N by E so ends. Lat 6° 4' S
Long 149° 00'

Sunday Jan. the 21 1844

first part wind from NNE
headed N by E double reefed topsails and
gills Middle part headed N by W under double
reefs latter part the same light squally sea
nothing but still off duty so ends. Lat 6° 30' S
Long 148° 48'

Monday Jan. the 22 1844

first part wind from NNE
with light squalls headed N by W at night
took in main sail and gills night reefed main
and mizen and double reefed fore topsail Middle
part headed N by W wind from N by W latter part
the same took in in the stowhouse boat
employed fitting of her so ends. Lat 6° 24' S
Long 148° 35'

Tuesday Jan. the 23 1844

first part wind from N headed
N by E started water and got out the
boat then the part headed N by W squally under
short sail latter part wind from N & light headed
N by W under all sail until 10 then steered
N by W watch employed in making spungers
so ends. Lat 6° 00' S
Long 147° 22'

Remarks On board Ship Martha Fairhaven Jan. 1844

Wednesday Jan. the 24 1844

first part light breeze from E with
light rain squalls making spungers in Middle part
steered S by W reefed topsails latter part all sail under
from E steered S by W of 4 so ends. Lat 6° 36' S
Long 148° 44'

Thursday Jan. the 25 1844

first part light breeze from
NNE steered S by W watch employed in ship's
duty at anchor took in topsails and gills
Middle part light air and calm latter part
wind from NNE steered S by W watch employed in
ship's duty so ends. Lat 6° 21' S
Long 148° 24'

Friday Jan. the 26 1844

first part light breeze from NNE
steered S by W watch employed in ship's duty
Middle part light air and rain steered S by W latter
part light air and calm took in the foremast
employed fitting of her so ends. Lat 6° 12' S
Long 149° 23'

Saturday Jan. the 27 1844

first part calm employed fitting
boat by Middle part light breeze from NNE steered
S by E latter part the same reefed at 8:55
Long 149° 49'

Sunday Jan. the 28 1844

first part light breeze from
NNE steered S by W finished the boat by
Middle part light breeze from N to E steered S light
squalls latter part wind from E light steered S by
E at 12 a light squall so ends. Lat 6° 30' S

Monday Jan. the 29 1844

first part light breeze from
NNE steered S by E Middle part light breeze from
NNE steered S latter part steered N by E at Meridian
saw an island ahead so ends. Lat 6° 10' S
Long 150° 20'
