Remarks Saturday July 10th
Fresh breeze from the NW steering ENE at 5 AM
saw took in the fore and main top sail
and left to the wind to the NE Middle part
lying by latter part light breeze from NW and
saw steering NE at 10 AM from the barque
pasha took off from the town 14 months out 240 NMs from
at Lat 40.00 N
Bar 29.90 & 71 Long 33.10 W

Remarks Sunday July 11th
Light airs from the North and saw steering both
Middle part moderate latter part light breeze
from ENE to North and pleasant steering NE
saw three sails Lat in 39.32 N
Bar 29.90 & 71 Long 32 40 W

Remarks Monday July 12th
Light breeze from the North and clear pleasant
weather steering ESE Middle part moderate
lying by latter part light breeze from the NW
saw clear steering different courses Lat in 40.09 N
Bar 29.90 & 74 Long 32 11 W

Remarks Tuesday July 13th
Light breeze from the NW and clear steering
ENE Middle part lying by at 9 AM saw
the Island of Carib bearing NE 40 miles distant
latter part fresh breeze from NW and
clear steering NE by saw barque headed
to the westward Lat in 40.10 N
Bar 29.90 & 74 Long 31.15 W

Remarks Wednesday July 14th
Fresh breeze from NW and clear steering NW
by saw several sails Middle part lying by
latter part fresh breeze from the NW steering
NE on the NW side of Flores Lat in 39.18 N
Bar 29.90 & 73 Flores bearing NE 10 miles

Remarks Thursday July 15th
Fresh breeze from the Westward running down
the East side of Flores saw 2 ships lying off and
on one the Bark Adventure and two Whaling
under Corvo Middle part fresh gales and specially
lying by at 7 AM Flores bore North 25 miles distant
latter part fresh gales from the NW steering NE heavy
swell on saw ship steering to the North
Bar 29.90 & 74 Lat in 38
Long 30.

Remarks Friday July 16th
Fresh gales from the NW and clear steering NE
Middle part lying by latter part fresh breeze from
the NW steering East at 4 AM saw Fayal bearing
East at 11 AM saw sperm Whales going to wind
quick to fast to lower for them saw several
whaling Barks Fayal bearing E by S
Bar 30. & 73

Remarks Saturday July 17th
Fresh gales from the NW and clear heavy swell
on on different tacks Middle part lying by
latter part fresh breeze and specially causing
saw several Whaling Barks Fayal bearing NE 25 miles
Bar 30. 72

Remarks Sunday July 18th
First part light breeze from the North causing to the
NW of Fayal Middle part calm
latter part light airs from the NW steering to
the eastward saw a ship Fayal bearing ENE 15 miles
