Sunday June 2d

begins with light airs and calms Boats in search of Whales at Night returned all but the third mat he chased it Whale till night then it was so thick he could not find the the Ship he was on shore through the at 5 P.M. sent in 2 Boats at 6 sent in the other saw one in 2 Whales could not get near them thus ends

Monday July 3

begins with light breezes from the N.E. at 4 P.M. the Boats came off and we got under way and stood out N.W. at 7 P.M. thick fog burst up the after yards and held the head yards riding N.E.

Tuesday July 4 begins

light airs and calms and thick fog at 6 P.M. arrived in 26 fathoms water stood up the Sails Middle part thick and rainy later part calmer at 8 P.M. it lifted up and we saw a Whale sound for him with the Boats were of they saw a Dead Whale hooked on to him and led him to the Ship with 5 Boats but dinner

Wednesday July 5

begins with calms and thick fog at 4 P.M. commenced cutting at 5 finished cutting at 9 9 commenced Hauling Middle part thick fog and some rain employed in Hauling going to anchor

Thursday July 6

begins with light airs and calms employed in Hauling and chasing Whales but with out success

Friday July 7

employed in Hauling all 14 Boats of in search of Whales at 4 P.M. returned at 10 got through Hauling Middle part calmer plenty of Whales all around but could not get fast chas all day with 5 boats at night give them up 15 or 20 Ships in Net and 15 Miles off

Saturday July 8

begins with calms Boats chasing Whales we have 5 Boats down but cant get fast at 4 P.M. give them up got Supper at 5 P.M. held all hands hook out the Main hatchway at 6 P.M. sent of 3 Boats in search of Whales the Ship keepers and one boat crew standing down Oil light breeze from the North and some fog

Sunday July 9

begins light breezes and fog 5 Boats of after Whales the rest standing Oil at 5 P.M. finished standing down stood down 40 lbs at 6 P.M. the Boats returned with out success Middle and thick fog lying to anchor

Monday July 10

begins with light breezes from the N.E. lying to anchor Middle part much the same all hands employed in Scraping Boon and Washing it thick fog

Tuesday July 11th

begins with thick fog Winds from the N.E. we have leave about 3 knot current it runs 6 hours N.W. and a N.E. at 3 P.M. it lifted up it lifted at 4 got under way and stood in that for the Main Land 15 Ships in Net at 7 P.M. hold over on it Wind toward the Shanties under Easy Sail at 8 A.M. raised a dead Whale sent a boat to him at 5 boats him along side commenced cutting at 8 P.M. finished cutting we anchored at 9 commenced Hauling sent of 8 Boats in pursuit of Whales Line over

Wednesday

begins with light breezes at 4 P.M. one Boat started and the others went to him got him dead and commenced towing to the Ship after they had led a great Boat the 1 Boat to be at 10 P.M. got him to the Ship Middle part windy and strong breezes employed in Hauling
