begins with light breezes from the West Steering East and E by South employed in repairing the fore Top Sail Middle and later part Modest at daylight Mad Gudsahap Island bearing ESE 10 Miles

begins with light breezes from the West Steering E by S at night took in the light Sails and light to the Wind heeling ESE at night the Mast bore ESE 10 Miles later part haphing of and on at daylight Steered in for the Island and sent in two Boats for Fishing

begins strong breezes from the NE being of and on at 4 o'clock the boats come up and Sail Steered E by S Mid and later fine weather the Watch employed in Ships Duty
