

Remarks on Sunday Dec 24

Begins with fine weather
light breezes from the NW Steaming East at
night took in the Top & Sail held up the courses
Doubled reef the fore and mizzen Top Sails
at hold down the Gills at 5 AM saw the Lander
Cerro Bland wore Ship heeled up with the
Main yard at 8 AM later part saw Black
fish heard for them but took them
on board

Remarks on Monday Dec 25

Begins with light breezes from the NW
heeding WSW at 2 PM took the fish in
at night took in Top & Sails Gills held
up the courses Ship heeding WSW

Middle and later parts fine weather at
daylight made Sail stood in for the Lander
the Watch employed Lat by Ch 28 29
Long 115 30

Remarks on Tuesday Dec 26

Begins with light
light air at 2 PM saw Blackfish Lander all
four boats struck about 1 PM and landed
4 took them on board Middle part light breezes
later part saw more land took 5 Blackfish

Remarks on Wednesday Dec 27

Begins with light
breezes from the NW Land 5 miles off at 2
PM took the fish on board and cleared
them away at night Shortened Sail heeding
Cut West Middle part stood in later Strong
breeze Doubled reef the fore and mizzen Top Sails
took in Gills and Main Sail wore of Shore

Long by Ch 116 17

Remarks on Thursday Dec 28

Begins with Strong breeze
from the NW heeding of WSW employed in
Ship's duty saw 4 Ship Lander in to the NE
Supposed to be 4 Whaler Middle part Strong
breeze later part much the same at 3 PM
commenced heeling over Black fish saw the
4 Bone Ship Lat by Ch 28 11
Long by Ch 116 10

Remarks on Friday Dec 29

Begins with Strong breeze
from the NE heeding in East at 5 PM
further heeling wore Ship to the NE
Middle and later parts light breezes made Sail
at 5 PM last to the NE Land 10 miles off

Lat by Ch 28 13

Remarks on Saturday Dec 30

Begins with light air
from the NE heeding out over all sail
out saw 4 Bone Ship at night 4 Whaler heeling
to the NE 4 Ship heeding NE Middle and
later parts light breeze and fine weather

Remarks on Sunday Dec 31

Begins with fine
weather Middle and later part much the
same land all 4 boats for 4 Whaler and
thought about they were ripe Blackfish Middle and
later parts light breezes heeding out Land
from 7 to 10 miles off saw plenty fine Bats

Remarks on Jan 1st (1855)

Begins with light
breezes from the NW the air and West
at 2 PM saw 4 Sail at 4 PM 4 Bone Ship
it was the Traw Capt Lawrence Middle
and later parts Strong breezes Doubled
reef later part ran of NE
