Remarks on Thursday May 3rd

Begins with Strong breezes and Sgaley some rain employed in making Sail and taking in the before required Middle part the Wind held out to the N.W. Ship under Double reef took in the Mainsail and Gill later part much the same

Remarks on Friday May 4th

Begins with fresh Gales from the N.W. Ship heading W.S. and N.W. by E under Double reef some Sgaley of rain Middle and later part more moderate Ship heading N.W. made some Sail

Begins with light breeze from the N.W. at 4 P.M. the Wind veered to the West made all Sail set the royal and four Top Staring Sail bears N.W. & fine weather Middle part moderate later part at 8 P.M. the Wind held to the West hoist up Staring held in Staring Sails thick fog

Remarks on Sunday May 6th

Begins with light breeze from the N.W. Ship heading W.S.E. at 2 P.M. tack to the West at 5 P.M. the Wind held to the N.E. coars N.W. by N Middle part light breeze from the S.E. coars N.W. & later part light breeze from the S.W. all Sail Staring Sails and Royal

Remarks on Monday May 7th

Begins with light breezes from the S.E. coars N.W. by N all Sail out down in Barks Middle part Strong breezes Winds held out to the N.W. heading to the N.W. at 10 P.M. Wore to the W.S.E.
