

Remarks on Sunday May 27th

Begins with light breezes from the South Steaming NW by W all Day out at 5 PM
Down 2 Ships on the barbed from Steaming to the North and West. Middle part light breezes
breezes from NW by W later part fresh Gales from SSE
At 10 AM took in four and all on Top 5 Sails
and Main Royal took in lower Steaming Sail
and top 5 Steaming Sails and on best them sent
Down the Booms held it raining Sat by the 5th 12 or
Sun by the 150th 20 E

Remarks on Monday May 28th

Begins with fresh Gales
and rain at 5 PM took in four Top Steaming
Sail at 6 PM thick fog. Winds turned to the
South doubled up the four and all on top
Sails at 8 PM left to the Wind. With the Main
yard. A bark heading to the NW at 5 AM kept
of held a thick fog ran under Short Sail
and kept the harn blowing Sat by the 5th 12 or
Sun by the 148th 23 E

Remarks on Tuesday May 29th

Begins with light breezes
from the South Steaming NW by W under Short
Sail thick fog we have not got at lat now
Longitude since we came through the Straits
Middle and later part light and heading to the
NW Saw 2 Ships
Sat by the 55th 54
Sun by the 144th 30

Remarks on Wednesday May 30th

Begins with light breezes from the NW at
4 PM last to the SW at 6 PM Saw the Sea last
to the South held up the courses thick fog
Middle part light and later part about 100 Ships
in set and plenty of Ice at 11 AM found all
four Boats and went in the Sea. Since island
about 25 Miles off bearing NW

Remarks on Thursday May 31st

Begins with fine weather the
Boats in the Sea at 1 PM one Boat went up to
20 Whales and met him at 5 PM another struck
and landed at 12 came on Board stood up from
the Sea Middle part moderate later part at 3 PM
board the 4 Boats went in the Sea in pursuit
of Whales Saw none at 11 PM returned on
Board spoke the Medicine & Whales Sat 50th 18
Jonas Island 20 Miles off Sea Sun 145th 22

Remarks on Friday June 1st

Begins with fine weather
at 1 PM found 4 Boats in pursuit of Whales
at 6 PM came on Board some 25 on 80 Ships
in set Middle part light breezes later part light
breezes sent in the Boats in the Sea See Whales
should not strike

Remarks on Saturday June 2nd

Begins with light breezes boats
in the Sea Saw Whales but could not get to
them on the account of the Ice at 6 PM spoke
the Lexington of Nantucket Capt Brock Middle
part moderate the current took about all the Ships
in the heavy ice Jonas Island 12 Miles off
later part light and breeze Ship surrounded
with heavy ice

Remarks on Sunday June 3rd

Begins with light breezes from the Westward
we started to come out of the Ice at 1 PM
thick fog at 5 PM we left the Wind doubled
up the Top Sails and held the heel yard aback
at 11 PM stood up the four and all on top
heavy ice all around we got out ropes and
made fast to some of the long barks later part
later part the fog lifted and so we went in
in the Sea we started to get out at 11 PM
of bearing by E
