

Remarks on Monday June 4th
 begins with light breezes
 from the S.E. heding to the N.E. out of the ice
 at 4 Bell got out left to the wind heeling
 Oby at about 15 Ships in Sit at 5 Bell thick
 fog Middle part into later part thick wither
 down about 12 Ships all heding to the S.W. trying
 to get round the ice. No Lat by Ob

Remarks on Tuesday June 5th
 begins with brisk breezes
 from the S.E. heeling S.W. at 4 Bell saw
 ice at 5 Bell thick fog took in Main
 Top & Sail and the S.E. heding to the S.W. main
 set thick fog later part much the same saw
 several Ships when the fog lifted little

Remarks on Wednesday June 6th
 begins with light breezes from
 the S.E. and foggy at 4 Bell it lifted up a
 little saw the Corvet Howe lashed Shinken
 along side at 6 Bell spoke him it was a one ton
 one Middle part thick fog later part much
 the same No Lat or Lon

Remarks on Thursday June 7th
 begins with light ares and calms
 and thick fog Scouring ice all round the Ships
 at 7 Bell spoke the George Washington of Vancouver
 Middle part calm and thick fog later part dit

Remarks on Friday June 8th
 begins with calms and
 thick fog and plenty of ice all round and plenty
 of Ships Middle part light ares S.W. and later
 part thick fog had 2 Bats at 10 Bell the Chapman's
 run down and spoke us No Lat by Ob
 Va Lon by Ob

Remarks on Saturday June 9th
 begins with light breezes
 from South to S.E. saw the A tyler and harvest
 20 Whales this Season spoke the George and Mary
 6 Whales kept on ran down the ice from N.W.
 to North by E at 7 1/2 Bell out on A wind S.W.
 Middle part thick fog and strong breezes from the
 S.E. heding to the N.E. the most of the time later part
 it lifted least full mad Sail stood to the north
 about 12 Ships in Sit ice in Sit and it is too
 heavy for the Ships to go in this thick weather

Remarks on Sunday June 10th Lon by Ob 143° 20' E
 begins with brisk breezes
 from the N.W. it lifted up a little and we stood
 in to the edge of the ice then I shot down thick
 more of and held it back Middle part modest
 later part went in the boats in to the ice saw
 Nothing Lat by Ob 55° 50' Lon 143° 00'

Remarks on Monday June 11th
 begins with light ares
 Ship in the ice at 7 Bell the Chapman of Ed
 spoke us 3 Whales this Season Middle and
 later part light ares and thick weather
 several Ships in Sit Lat by Ob 55° 59'

Remarks on Tuesday June 12th
 light ares and calms at 10
 Capt precise came on board Middle part
 calm Middle part light ares and calm and
 fog

Remarks on Wednesday June 13th
 begins with light ares and calms and fog
 Middle and later parts much the same
 at 10 Bell the John Wells spoke us and
 the Capt came on Board
