

Remarks on Thursday June 14th

begins with light breezes and foggy at 4 PM took the young Phoenix of Van Bredona Middle part Madnet Saw Tomas Island the Edgan of Gold Starings went on Shore than it few days it go and she was to catch the No lines lost Later part sent in 3 boats to see what they could get hand of ash & oil going on Shore led it to the Ship and we took it in at 10 AM it shot down foggy the Island and of Sit and the boats

Remarks on Friday June 15th

begins with calmness and fog at 2 PM it lifted and we were in the ice at 7 PM the boats returned the ship had been out on fire and part of her oil was burnt with her own boats got from the wreck one Grand Stone to anchors and at once and some other things we put up some last empty ones while and later light breezes and fine weather Tomas Island 15 miles of having West

Remarks on Saturday June 16th

begins with pleasant breezes from the SW Steaming We at 3 PM put up a bush of Shook Staves and one lb of Wash Middle part Strong breezes from the SW at 9 PM came up to the ice part it heading WNW at 3 PM last to the SE 5 ships in Sit

Lat by Gh 56° 52' Lon 142° 15'

Remarks on Sunday June 17th

begins with strong breezes from the SW heading WNW at 2 PM except the other Top Sail at 5 PM could not except the foam at 7 PM caught the Main plenty of ice in Sit Madnet and later part entered the ice Lat by Gh 56° 52' Lon 141° 50'

Remarks on Monday June 18th

begins with fine weather the Main Land in Sit 10 Miles of Middle part standing on it later part strong breezes could not except the top Sails at 11 AM more weather mad Sail kept South 9 ships in Sit Lat by Gh 56° 21' Lon by Gh 139° 20'

Remarks on Tuesday June 19th

begins with fine weather Winds from the SW heading West at 4 PM last to the SE at 6 PM part the Steamer in front for Stealing Middle part fine weather being up to the island along the ice at 8 PM sent in the boats saw nothing at 11 PM came on board at big Shanties in Sit having SW Lat by Gh 55° 40'

Remarks on Wednesday June 20th

begins with light breezes from the SE at 1 PM Land 4 boats for 5 PM last at 3 PM struck and held took him to the ship and but him saw more Land struck another at 10 PM took him to the ship at 3 PM came on board at 6 finished board for more could not Struck at 12 came on board Lat by Gh 55° 45' W

Remarks on Thursday June 21st

begins with fine weather Middle and later parts much the same Shanties in Sit later part employed in hugging Lat by Gh 55° 25'

Remarks on Friday June 22nd

begins with light breezes from the West round the ice employed in hugging Middle part thick fog at 9 PM held it back later part at 11 PM up at little light and and Gabriel saw a dead Grampus land and took him to the ship held him in back of boat him but Lat by Gh 55° 18' Lon by Gh 138° 45'
