

Remarks on Saturday June the 23

Begins with light breezes from the North and East employed in boyling about 12 Ships in Sit the big Shanties 10 Miles off Middle part foggy had a back part of the Night later part much the same winds light and from the NW part of the time on on tack and part on the other Sat by 11 55 1600

Remarks on Sunday June 24th

Begins with light ares from the NW heading NW at 5 PM Sounded 44 fath at 5 PM None Ships to the East Sat the Main Top 3 Sail Middle and later parts foggy at 11 AM it lifted up a little Saw the Shanties 15 Miles off

Remarks on Monday June 25
begins with light ares from the NW heading down to the Sea Several Ships in Sit to 6 PM Kitten came on Board at 4 PM Saw Whales and board for them but could not get past Middle and later parts foggy

Remarks on Tuesday June 26th
begins with fogs and thick Easterly winds at 1 PM it lifted Saw Whales board struck one in the Sea he took the line and went of Middle part thick fog later part much the same

Remarks on Wednesday June 27
begins with light ares from the West Saw Whales board struck one and parted from him at 8 PM came on Board Saw the Admarcane Middle part moderate later part Saw Whales board but could not strike at 12 o'clock day came on Board

Remarks on Thursday June 28th

Begins with light ares Saw a Ship pick up a Whale Saw the Shanties changing Middle part calm later parts much the except a thick fog

Remarks on Friday June 29th

Begins with light breezes from the NW working round the Sea Saw a Ship pick up a Middle part thick fog winds from the NE later part some rain Saw a Whale board for him could not strike at 6 AM came on Board at 11 AM could not with out success came on board

Remarks on Saturday June 30

Begins with light breezes from the NW heading in to the NW Saw several Ships some under way and others to Anchor 15 Miles off Middle and later parts moderate working round the Sea Saw a few Sighting Whales and many Wild could not get near them

Remarks on Sunday July 1st

Begins with light ares and calm Saw nothing but Ships Middle part calm later part light breezes from the East heading along the Land Sent in 3 Boats in search of Whales at 10 AM told them our Board took up

Remarks on Monday July 2nd

Begins with light ares from the East at 4 PM it was calm and we struck the Kyrard Arkland about 20 Miles from us Saw the Admarcane cutting a Whale at 6 PM the Sea came down with the tide A hunt was Middle part moderate later part sent in three Boats in search of Whales at 7 PM we got under way Sat the flag for the Boats
