

Remarks on Tuesday July 3^d
begins with light airs
from the East backing and falling
the Ice and Land at 9 P.M. came to Anchor
Winds from the NE. Middle part Strong breeze
and rainey Later part Strong Gale came from
Ship's point on Ship

Remarks on Wednesday July 4th
begins with Strong Gale from the NE
we had about 5 Miles from the Land
in 16 fathoms of Water with 2000 fathoms
grounded Anchor with 10 fathoms of Chain out
at 3 P.M. we took one place of the Anchor
and let go the other but it did not bring
her up she still drag on to the Land but
we got ready to pay the Chances and expect to
have to Slip but it being on the last half of
the tide we did not drift so fast at 5 we
hove up both the Land and the Anchor
and the second Anchor was paid we hauled
it out the Ship and Main Top Sail and the East
tid made and it moderated some heavy rain
at 8 we anchored again thick and foggy Middle
part till at 1 P.M. later part took our Anchor
and stood to the Eastward Winds NEW took in the
Anchor and part Another on the bar
about 20 Ships in Sit

Remarks on Thursday July 5th
begins with light breezes from the West
standing over toward the Charter Islands
made Sit thick and rainey at 1 P.M. Sun. A
Whale heard struck him close to the Ship he took
the line and went up in the Ice Middle part
modest Later part Saw Whales heard struck and
killed him he went in the Ice and we lost from
him and lost him we saw are between the
Shanties and Main

Remarks on Friday July 6th
begins with fine weather
Fire struck on the back in the Ice and
then came out the Boat struck him again
him he then went in the Ice and we got it in
to the Ship and hauled him out Middle part moderate
at 3 P.M. commenced buting at 8 finished mad Sail
ready to the West

Remarks on Saturday July 7th
fine weather winds from the East Steaming to the
West at 7 P.M. commenced buting held to the SE
Middle part fine weather Later part till at 1 P.M. Sun. A
Whale heard 3 boats employed in buting the Whale went in
the Ice could not get past about 20 Ships in Sit none doing
any thing

Remarks on Sunday July 8th
begins with Strong breezes from the
East could not get the Top Sails took in the Ship at
6 P.M. rainey at 7 anchored Middle heavy rain could
take the Water Later part till

Remarks on Monday July 9th
at 1 P.M. commenced buting
calm Middle part finished buting Later part
light airs and thick about 20 Ships in Sit

Remarks on Tuesday July 10th
begins with light breeze
calm breeze lying to Anchor till 6 part much the
same Later part hove out the other hole
and commenced Staving till at 7 P.M. took the Anchor

Remarks on Wednesday July 11th
breeze from the NE Steaming to the SW at
5 P.M. finished Staving Oil stood down as the 1 P.M.
Spoke the buting on could not get the top sail Middle
and later part light airs and calm
