

Remarks on Thursday July 12th
begins with light airs and
foggy weather at 5 Bell Sounded and found 9 fathoms
of water Dript anchor the bariton picket in
company Middle and later light airs and calm
and long current 7 fathoms at low water

Remarks on Friday July 13th
begins with thick weather and foggy
winds from the NE Ship Drag and we give
her more chance but poor holding ground
includ to drag at 9 Bell let in the Second
Anchor and give her 60 fathoms on each
at 5 Bell held all hands and took a cast
tid took our anchors and stood over to the
Main Saw about 20 Ships Most of them at
anchor at 9 we tack of at 11 nearly calm
an strong tid led to let go anchor in 15 fathoms
blud down the top Sails and hold out the rig in

Remarks on Saturday July 14th
begins with thick fogs and
NE wind sailing to anchor Middle and later
part much the same

Remarks on Sunday July 15th
begins with thick weather winds
from the NE at 4 Bell it tilted down
20 Ships Most of them at anchor Middle part
mod at 1 Bell the See came down with the tid
on at 2 held all hands in order to take
our anchor but the current being strong and
very we could not get it at 6
heaving and gut short gait in time
so at 7 we wore up and sail stand
in NW in or East tid thick fog at 11 1/2 calm
dropt the anchor blud down the top Sails
I held up a little Saw 2 or 3 Ships

Remarks on Monday July 16th
begins with light breezes from the NE and
thick weather foggy the most of the time at 1 Bell
put the bariton Middle part fresh breezes and foggy
at 4 later part light breezes and foggy at 9 Bell the
Ses of the bariton Drifted by us and held to know
if we heard any chance to spare him all he heard
more about 80 fathoms he finally anchored and
laine on board I let him have a spare chance
we heard 95 fathoms Wain 5000 35 lbs at 13 ct
he under took a bariton from Capt. Harise on
Dutch in Honalla at 12 Mid Day they took it
to the bariton

Remarks on Tuesday July 17th
begins with light airs from the East and this
Middle much the same later light airs and
calm at 10 Bell took our anchor at 9 Bell
anchored and I went on board the John Wells

Remarks on Wednesday July 18th
begins with calm at 4 Bell took a light
air from the West took our anchor and
stood over towards the See and the bariton
at Night on board at 4 Bell gut under way and
stood in for the Shanters at 10 Bell Board 2 Boats
for Whales at 3 Bell Dript our anchor and leaned
the other 2 Boats

Remarks on Thursday July 19th
begins with light breezes from
NE at 1 Bell one Boat laine on board took the
Anchor and stood in further towards the land
and anchored at 5 Bell the bariton
Board with our Success Middle part
mod much the same sailing of
Whales the boats cruising for Whales
