Middle part thick fog at 9 AM sent 3
three Boats in the fog in search of Whales

Remarks on Monday July 30th
at 6 PM the Boats returned with
out Success got Supper 2 Whales Lann
all 4 Boats Struck one turned him up got
the Ship under way at 9 PM took him
along side at 3 PM sent 3 Boats in
search of Whales but in the above whale
with one Boats crew and Ship keepers Middle
and later parts calm and part of the time
foggy boats all 4 chasing Whales

Remarks on Tuesday July 31st
begins with light airs and calm
boats still at in search of Whales at
1 PM returned Middle part foggy at 2 PM
sent 2 Boats in the fog after Whales
the others employed in Braking out the
4 four coal to Star down Oil

Remarks on Wednesday July August 1st
begins with brisk breezes from the East
2 Boats in search of Whales and the others
Storing Tackel Oil Star down 75 lbs at 6
PM finished. at 6 the Boats came aboard
Middle and later parts thick and rainy
at 3 1/2 got breakfast sent 4 Boats at 6 AM
returned it rain hard the Lexington in
the night anchored close to us at 7 AM 3
went on board of her at 8 PM

Remarks on Thursday August 2nd

begins with light Easterly winds and
thick fog Middle part 10 AM ship lying to anchor
later part took in anchor and stood over for
Blossum Bay thick fog at 11 AM anchored at 11
AM 1/2 Star down Oil and went to him

Remarks on Saturday August 4th

begins with light breezes went all 4 Boats to the
the Whales to the Ship at 1 PM 1 Boat came to
the Ship bore up the anchor at 3 PM took
him along side at 7 PM finished cutting and
stowed the Whale Middle and later parts modest
employed in Bayling

begins with light breezes employed in Bayling
took our anchor in Crum. got in for the
harbor to get Wood and Water later part
anchored in the Bay 5 or 6 Ships in

begins with light airs and calm Middle
and later part sent 3 Boats for Wood and
the rest getting Araft in for water got 6
boat loads of

Remarks on Tuesday August 7th
begins with calm Middle part brisk breezes at
5 PM got breakfast sent 3 Boats after Wood the
rest employed in Storing Oil Star down 75 lbs got
of 6 Boat loads of Wood

employed in Wooding Middle part modest
later part sent in 6 Boats and fild the raft and
got it of one Boat on Shore after 13 pms and
Wood
