

Remarks on Monday August 27

All hands employed in fishing and chasing Whales at 2 PM finished eating at 5 PM struck another Baid and took him to the ship but he was three boats off at 6 PM finished butting commenced Bayling

Remarks on Tuesday August 28th
light breezes employed in Bayling three boats of chasing Whales at night returned Mr Kenney still Sick of Duty Middle and later parts light breezes boats of in search of Whales

Remarks on Wednesday August 29
begins with light breezes boats of in search of Whales and employed in Bayling Middle and later parts much the same

Remarks on Thursday August 30
begins with calmness the boats of Whaling they struck 2 and Baid and put the ship under way and took them along side Middle and later part calmness boats of and the rest of us butting at 1 PM finished butting

Remarks on Friday August 31
begins with light breezes the boats of Whaling and the rest Bayling at night returned Middle part brisk breezes later Ditt at 8 PM got under way stood over for Blaine Bay employed in Bayling and Steaming down

Remarks on Saturday September 1
brisk breezes from the West all hands employed in Steaming Oil at 6 PM we took the station and stood in to the bay 18 ships in at 8 the Cape of Edgar came in Middle part Strong breezes later Ditt employed in Steaming Oil and the Doctor on board again

Remarks on Sunday September 2nd
begins with light breezes employed in Steaming Oil in the fore part at 6 PM finished Middle and later part Strong breezes from the West and Sgaley and rainey being at anchor in Blaine Bay Middle part Strong breezes from the West later Ditt

Remarks on Monday September 3rd
begins with Strong breezes Middle part much the same later Ditt all hands employed in cleaning Boon and Drying it

Remarks on Tuesday September 4th
begins with fresh Gales from the West Middle part much the same later part all hands employed in cleaning Boon

Remarks on Wednesday September 5th
begins with brisk breezes from the East and thick and rainey Middle part steam of the Wind came out to the North at 5 PM took anchor all hands stood out of the Bay at 8 PM when Whales board but they were going fast at 10 PM board with 10 killed

Remarks on Thursday September 6th
begins with calmness at 4 PM the boats came on board we got under way stood to the West Middle part calmness later part light breezes standing to the West between at 6 PM sent off 2 boats at 10 PM boat went on shore for wood at 11 PM when Whales board the other boat set the sails for the Boat on shore

Remarks on Friday September 7th
begins with light breezes at 2 PM struck 2 Whales Baid took to the ship at 4 PM struck another Baid at dusk took him to the ship and anchored at dusk commenced butting at 6 PM saw 10 Whales sent one boat to it the rest out in the 5 PM
