begins with strong breezes from the NE
employed in cutting at 5 Bell finished cutting
and commenced drying middle part. Vito. Later
part much the same

Remarks on Sunday Sept 9th
at 1 Bell finished drying the Stenters
and took our anchor to go in Blumens
Bay the wind left us and we anchored
middle part. brist breezes later part
fresh Gales from the NW at 3 Bell
hoisted up the anchor and kept the
top sails and stood for Blumens Bay
but it thick and rainy

Remarks on Monday Sept 10th
at 3 Bell anchored in the center road
in Sit of the Shipping. Middle part strong
breezes later part Vito. Employed in drying
and storing Oil in the after hold

Remarks on Tuesday Sept 11th
begins with moderate breezes from the NW
sailing at Ankon Bay and storing Oil
Middle part the wind veered to the West and
became on at 5 still held all hands and
under took to take our anchor home in
to the 45 Shabla and the hole of the patent
Gear broke as we head to Slip it for the
safety of the Ship and set double reef top sails
and run out of the NE passage

Remarks on Wednesday Sept 12th
begins with Bgaly. Weather winds from West
to North heading to the N and East at 5 Bell
sprake the China Middle part Salma later part
light breeze from the West at 11 still gale through
Sailing. Brought still in Sit. bears ESE all
put out

Remarks on Thursday September 13th
begins with light breezes from the NW employed
in clearing up getting the anchor on the beam and
upon the bears E by N Middle part Modest later
Vito all hands Employed in storing down Oil and
clearing Boon
Lat by Ch 55.49.18
Lon by Ch 140 40.8

Remarks on Friday Sept 14th
begins with light breezes from the
West Staring ESE all sail out all hands
Employed in storing down Oil at 2 Bell finished
storing middle part Modest later part much the
same at 10 M A still saw Green Island having SE by
Lat by Ch 56.22

Remarks on Saturday Sept 15th
begins with light breezes from the
SW was E by S employed in bending top sails
and top of sails Middle and later parts Modest
the watch employed in drying and cleaning
Boon Winds from West bears E by S Lat by Ch 56.03
Lon by Ch 146.30.8

Remarks on Sunday Sept 16th
begins with fine weather
Winds from the West bears E by S all sail
out middle part thick and light breezes later
part winds from the South and SW was E by S and
ESE
Lat by Ch 55.55.18
Lon by Ch 148.16.0

Remarks on Monday Sept 17th
begins with brisk breezes
from the SW and NW was SE all sail
out very heavy with and later parts modest
later part fresh Gales at 5.21 still Spake the
Vicecapt. I went on board of him
at 11 still returned
