and Star's Wind North and NNE Sat by Ch 46 00 W
Lon by Ch 177 51 E

Remarks on Sunday Oct 14th
begins with strong
from North to NNE heading East at 4 Bell Sat by
took four Sail rather more Madvet had sea on
Middle part much the same at daylight Sat double
top Sails and Main Sail and Gile later part
fresh breezes from the North coasts ESE
Lat by Ch 44 15 W

Remarks on Monday Oct 15th Lon by Ch 179 00 E
begins with fresh breezes
from the North Steering ESE Shock out reefs
and Sat top 5 Sails Middle and later parts moderate
breezes from the NE heading to the ESE all Sail
out the Watch employed in Ships duty
Lat by Ch 43 12 W

Remarks on Tuesday Oct 16th Lon by Ch 178 45 W
begins with light breezes from
ESE at 4 Bell broad round the yards heading
NE at 6 Bell Wind heard to the South coasts
E by W all Sail out 1 Sail in Sit
Middle part fresh breezes from the NW all Sail
out later part Steered East 1 Sail in Sit
Lat by Ch 42 50 W
