begins with brisk trades from the NE at 3 o'clock we left Honolulu for the second time & then in Swans at 4 o'clock Discharging the Pilot Boat plant Steam Ship & later part saved away the 1st boom sent him the Carpenter employed in making another

Remarks on Friday Dec 7th

begins with calm Middle part into later part light breeze from the SE Ship heading SE all sail out took on 4 men that denied doing duty told them up by the thunders they were soon glad to obay to go to their duty let them down and sent them forward

Lat by Ch 17° 45' N

Remarks on Sat Dec 8th Lon by Ch 158° 20' W

begins with light breeze from the SE Ship heading SE all sail out except by in getting the 1st 1st boom ready and painting boats Middle part light trades later part much the same the watch employed in sending out the 1st boom later 13° 02'

Lon by Ch 159° 10' W

Remarks on Sunday Dec 9th

begins with calms at 2 o'clock took light breeze from the NE cross SE all sail set hole in and set the Storing sails Middle part light breeze from the SE Ship by the wind heading SE later part winds East Ship on at wind heading SE all sail out

Lat by Ch 17° 56' N
Lon by Ch 158° 20' W

Remarks on Monday Dec 10th

begins with light breeze from East Ship on at wind heading SE all sail out Middle part light trades from the East heading SE all sail out later part much the same the watch getting the boats ready for shipping

Lat by Ch 16° 01' N
Lon by Ch 158° 06' W

Remarks on Tuesday Dec 11th

begins with brisk trades from the East heading on at wind SE all sail out Middle part brisk trades Ship heading SE by 1 o'clock in the air Royal later part took in 1st boom top of sail and 1st 1st the watch employed in Ship's duty Lat by Ch 13° 51' N

Lon by Ch 157° 50' W

Remarks on Wednesday Dec 12th

begins with brisk trades from the NE cross SE all sail out Middle part brisk trades later part more moderate but hot

Lat by Ch 11° 29' N
Lon by Ch 156° 28' W

Remarks on Thursday Dec 13th

begins with light breeze from the NE all sail out the watch employed Middle part brisk trades heading SE by 1 o'clock all sail out later part much the same Lat by Ch 9° 13' N

Lon by Ch 155° 55' W

Remarks on Friday Dec 14th

begins with brisk trades from the NE and ESE all sail out Ship heading SE by 1 o'clock Middle part strong trades later part 1st boom took in 1st 1st sails

Lat by Ch 7° 25' N
Lon by Ch 155° 00' W
