

Ship Mary Looking for Whales
 Thurs 12 Moderate breeze from northward
 with squalls steering ESE saw nothing
 Middle part steered SE under
 topsails
 Latter part steering east one Whaling
 Bark in sight Lat Obs 36° 31' N
 Long chro 40° 18' W

Fri 13 Begins with a fresh breeze from
 Westward steering East saw Frampuses
 and a carcass 3 sails in sight
 Middle part steering ESE & NE spoke
 Bark Malta of new Bedford 2 months
 out clean 2 other sails in sight
 on bent the spanker to make it smaller
 Lat Obs 36° 55' N
 Long 38° 36' West

Sat 14 Begins with a strong breeze from
 West steering NE looking for whales
 Middle part took in sail and headed
 NNE by the wind blowing strong
 Latter part took in fore & mizen topsails
 Steered NE at 11 AM closed reefed main
 Topsail and let the ship come to the
 Wind Bowing hard from West bad sea on
 and raining No observation

Sun 15 Moderated some verry squally with
 much rain heading up NNE under
 closed reefed main topsail & foresail
 Middle part bad sea on heading NE
 by the wind
 latter part by the wind to the
 Eastward under double reefed Topsails
 Lat Obs 38° 27' N
 Long chro 37° 18' W

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Mon 16 Begins with a strong breeze from NW
 & WNW steering NE see nothing
 Middle part moderate breeze with
 a heavy swell on heading to the Eastward
 Latter part wore ship to the NW
 Light breeze and rough Lat Obs 39° 40' N

Tues 17 Begins with a light breeze from NE
 heading to the northward by the wind
 Middle part lay up NE wind SE
 under short sail
 Latter part steering NE all sail set
 Strong breeze saw a whaling Brig
 steering to the southward
 Lat Obs 41° 00' N
 Long chro 36° 23' W

Wednes aug 18 Strong breeze and rough
 steering NE wind southward
 Middle part under double reefed
 Topsails and lufed to the wind
 blowing hard and raining
 Latter part squally at 8 AM cleared
 up made sail bad sea on steered NE
 Lat Obs 42° 12' N
 Long chro 35° 52' W

Thurs 19 Begins with a moderate breeze with
 a bad sea on steering NE with
 Double reefed topsails
 Middle part steering ENE under
 short sail bad sea on
 Latter part steering ENE and heavy
 swell saw nothing Lat Obs 43° 40' N
 Long chro 33° 11' W
