

Ship Mary Towards Porgus Banks

Thurs September 16th 1852

Begins with a strong breeze from S W^W
heading S E by the wind 1 sail in
sight saw porpoises
Middle part strong breeze from S W^W
S W S W^W heading to the southward
by the wind
Latter part by the wind to the southward
firing the spanker gaff 2 sails in sight
Lat Obs 30° 17' N
Long Chro 19° 30' W

Friday 17th Begins with a strong breeze
from W S W heading up S by E sent
up spanker gaff
Latter part tacked to the N W by W
heavy head swell took in Jib & main sail
— latter part heading S by E by the wind
a brig in sight Lat Obs 29° 58' North

Satur Sept 18th Begins with a strong breeze
from S W by the wind to the southward
2 Brigs in sight
Middle part heading W N W by W
tacked to the southward
Latter part heading up S S W by the wind
Long Obs 29° 35' N

Sun 19th Begins with a light air and calm with
a swell from N W heading S W by S
by the wind
Middle part light air from N W
steering S W by S
Latter part light breeze from N W steering
S W by S saw nothing Lat 28° 50' N
Long 19° 22' W

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Monday Sep 20th 1852

Begins with a moderate breeze north
steering S W by S
Middle part light baffling breeze
1 sail in sight Lat Obs 27° 14' N
Long Chro 19° 44' W

Tues 21st Begins with a light breeze from
Westward heading S W by S
Middle & latter part squally & rainy
with thunder and lightning
wind from all ways

Wednes 22nd Begins with rain and thunder
and lightning wind S E steering S W by S
Middle part squalls of rain with thunder
& lightning
Latter part moderate wind S W by S
Lat Obs 26° 25' N
Long Chro 20° 17' W

Thurs 23rd Begins with a light breeze from S W^W
heading S E by the wind
Middle part wind West steering S W by S
Latter part calm a brig in sight
Lat Obs 25° 54' N

Fri 24th Begins with a light breeze from N W
steering S W by S employed on the riggin
saw nothing
Middle part fresh breeze from N N E
pleasant steering S S W
Latter part fresh trades & pleasant
employed on the riggin
Lat 24° 30' N
Long 21° 16' W
