 The fore part moderate trades winds with
 all sail set
 The middle and latter part fresh trades
 winds and squally slowed top gallants
 and fly gib the fore part bent the
 close mizen ship leak this day was 300 strokes

Monday November the 1st 1852
 The fore part fresh trades and squally
 Stowed top gallant sails and singled
 ruffed the top sails
 The middle part steady trades made top
 gallant sails and fly gib
 the latter part made hole mizen top sail
 saw a sail standing to southward
 The watch employed on ships duty
 The ship leak this day was 400 strokes

Tuesday Nov the 2^d
 The fore part fresh trade winds all this day under all
 sail the weather cloudy
 The watch employed ratten top gallant
 rigging and fitting chafeing gear on
 the shrouds fitting new fore buntlin
 blocks and set up the royal rig
 started water into the scuttle but and
 filled the casks with salt water took down
 a new boat from the ~~store~~ and fitted
 it for whaling ship leak as before

 The fore part fresh gale and cloudy
 under all sail
 The middle part squally attended with
 rain single reefed top sails fore and

 The latter part thick weather and rain
 NE ship leak this day was 500 strokes

Remarks on board Thursday Nov the 4th
 The fore part fresh gale and thick Rainy
 weather stored top gallant sails
 The middle part heavy squalls double
 reefed top sails stored main sail and
 gib attended with steady rain
 the latter part the same with a heavy
 sea from Eastward
 The ship leak this was 600 strokes

Friday Nov the 5th
 The fore part of this fresh gale and Rain
 at sun down close reefed the main top
 sail the weather being squally
 The middle part moderated down to
 light breeze made hole main top sail
 and main top gallant sail
 the latter part light air and cloudy
 made all sail
 The watch employed on ships duty
 ship leak this day was 440 strokes
