Light breeze & squalls of Rain ^{watch} Employed
at different jobs aboard watch on liberty
Later part Light air & fine weather one watch
on liberty mason in the fort

Monday May the 9th
Light breeze & pleasant one watch on liberty
Later part fresh breeze & Rainy watch on
shore the cooper put in the fort for breaking
his liberty some hands Employed at small
jobs so Ends

Tuesday May the 10th
fresh breeze & squalls of Rain one watch
on shore the other Employed receiving
Recruits & other jobs

Wednesday May the 11th
fresh breeze & Rainy one watch on shore
Employed at ship's duty
Later part strong breeze squalls of Rain
all hands Employed taking in water &
other jobs

Thursday May the 12th
fresh breeze & cloudy all hands Employed
stowing down water and other small
jobs Later part watch on liberty some
hands Employed receiving Recruits

Friday May the 13th
Light breeze & fine weather one watch on
shore the other watch Employed at different
jobs so Ends
capt. Stumbers tried to get Mr Jennings out
of the ship & through my means he has
stayed in the ship

courses Wicks Saturday May the 14th

fresh breeze & heavy all hands Employed
clearing up the deck & have up the starboard
anchor took mason & cooper out of the fort
Mr starter the seckont mate pounded the
carpenter knocked him down & abused the
hole ship's crew the steward shot his thumb with
a pistol so that he was of duty

Sunday May the 15th sea account
Begin light breeze & fine weather ^{at 3 PM} got underway
and steering out the passage with a light
standing sea breeze from the southward
watches Later part light air & cloudy all sail set Employed
N.E. steering the anchors & other jobs Leak 300
in Little all 4 hands sick solomon boils frank portagee
right in front ashly

Monday May the 16th
N.E. E.S.E. fore part fresh breeze & squalls of Rain land
tack ship in sight Employed at different jobs
S.E. E.N.E. Middle & latter parts strong breeze & Rainy
the under single Keefed top sails the watches
Employed at different jobs Leak 700 strokes
four hands sick Lat by 0115

Tuesday May the 17th under short sail
E.S.E. N.E. the fore part moderate gale & Rainy the
watch Employed at ship duty
E N.W. Middle & latter parts fresh gale & squalls
of Rain under close Keefed main top sail
Bspencers Leak 800 S Lat by 0115
saw a fin back

Wednesday May the 18th
E N.W. A strong breeze & squalls of Rain
the watch Employed at ship's duty
E by N S Middle & latter parts strong breeze &
cloudy under close top sails three hands
sick ship's leak 1200 str Lat by 0115
