 Friday July the 22nd Long by chron
 W by N SE A strong breeze & hazy all sail set saw 1 fin back
 W N W E SE painting the iron work at 5 Pm double keeled the
 very squally & fresh middle & latter parts blowing hazy in
 W by N Squalls attended with Rain started fresh water
 saw 1 fin back leak 400 S Lat by orls
 Saturday July the 23rd Long by chron
 W by N SE the fore part moderate gale & squalls of Rain put
 SS W Frank & shly in irons for fighting with frank
 steering to portage at 3 Pm stowed the fore & mizen top sails
 the SS W and left to the wind one sail in sight at 5 Pm took
 SS W & shly out of irons Middle & latter parts fresh gale
 & squalls of Rain saw 1 fin back 2 sails in sight
 ships leak 650 S Lat by orls
 Sunday July the 24th Long by chron
 S W SSE moderate gale & Rugged under close Keel fore and
 W S W SE main top sails & fore sail 1 sail in sight seen 1 fin back
 W Middle & latter parts strong breeze & hazy under short
 the cap. under sail so Ends leak as before Lat by orls 15 = 42 south
 took to make all hands drink salt water W Long by chron 32 = 09 W
 Monday July the 25th loaded his first lot of action
 W SE Fresh trade winds & hazy W under close Keel top
 sails & fore sail 2 sails in sight steering to the S W
 at sun down left to the wind Middle & latter parts
 SS W fresh breeze & hazy saw 1 fin back & porpoises
 W one sail in sight steering to the N
 ships leak 600 Lat by orls
 started fresh water Long by chron

 NE fin backs at sun down left to the wind heading N E
 W Middle & latter parts fresh breeze & hazy seen 1 fin

 Lat by orls
 Wednesday July the 27th Long by chron
 W E SE Moderate breeze & fine Weather under close Keel top
 sail & fore sail saw 1 fin back the W Employed at
 E different jobs Middle & latter parts light winds & hazy
 saw 1 fin back leak 300 S Lat by orls
 Long by chron
 Thursday July the 28th
 W E Light breeze & clear W under short sail the W
 N E Employed at different jobs saw 1 fin back & a inglish
 the ship steering S W at sundown left to the wind
 W E SE latter part light air & fine weather saw 1 fin back and
 pieces of squid leak 250 Lat by orls
 Long by chron
 Friday July the 29th
 W S W E SE the fore part light air & pleasant W all straining
 S S W SE sail set - saw porpoises & all back at sun down
 shortened sail at daylight made sail light breeze &
 fine W 2 sails in sight saw 1 fin back & all back
 leak as before Lat by orls
 Long by chron 36 = 37 W
 Saturday July the 30th
 S W SE Light air & fine W all sail set seen 1 fin back & 1
 porpoises Rave new fore top sail chelines & burst
 lines at 4 Pm sent a boat on board the frigate 3 P
 sage of New York 62 days out bound to California
 S by W NE Middle & latter parts light air & calm 2 sails in
 sight saw all back the watch Employed
 taring the fore Rigging leak 150 S
 Lat by orls
 Long by chron
