Monday Nov the 7th

N A fresh breeze & hazy weather Middle & latter parts
W Strong breeze & squalls of hail & rain Employed at
different jobs so ends

Wednesday Nov the 9th

SE A strong breeze & rainy weather 2 boats looking for Wood
SSE Middle & latter parts blowing heavy in squalls &
attended with hail & rain

Thursday Nov the 10th

SSE the fore part fresh gale & hail squalls 2 boats on
shore after Wood
S Middle & latter parts the same so ends

Friday Nov the 11th

SE A moderate gale from the southward & eastward and
ESE Rainy all these 24 hours

Saturday Nov the 12th

ESE the fore part strong breeze & rainy Middle part
E moderate breeze latter part fresh gale & squalls of
hail & rain

Sunday Nov the 13th

E A fresh gale attended with hail & snow
SE Middle part strong breeze
NE Latter part light breeze & rainy weather

Monday Nov the 14th

NE A strong breeze attended with snow & rain at 3 PM
E the 2 boats came on board ^{in self & 10 men with me} to try to benefit the
SE Middle & latter parts moderate gale & snow squalls Employed
S blacksmithing & other jobs

SW A strong breeze from SW Employed at different jobs
S Middle & latter parts fresh breeze & rainy all hands Employed
