Mr Little still off duty

Tuesday March the 28th
S WSW light breeze & fine clear all sail set
at 3 P.M. delivered the log Book up to the Capt at his
orders & account book of small stores (duty)
Latter part fine pleasant Weather Realm Mr Little off

Wednesday March the 29th
SW N light from the breeze from the northward steering SW
Mr Little full sail set middle part fresh breeze latter strong
W N.W. breeze & clear all hands refused to whaleing but
duty would work ship homeward bound

Thursday March the 30th
W N.W. strong breeze from the N.W. heading NE
W. ship middle & latter parts fresh breeze & clear Weather
heading NE all hands employed fitting standing
sail gear Mr Little off duty no mast heads
Lat 44-50 S standing

Friday March the 31st Long 61-10
NE N.W. moderate breeze from N.W. heading NE
caught 2 porpoises middle & latter parts strong
breeze from the southward & Westward set S
fore top mast & standing sail
Mr Little off duty

NE S.W. fresh breeze from S.W. fine Weather steering NE
all hands employed at ship's duty middle part light
breeze latter part strong breeze & Rainy steering NE
Mr Little off duty Long 58-04 West
Lat 42-56 South

Sunday April the 2nd
N.E. E Begins with a moderate gale & light Rain at 3 P.M. thick
E.S.E. NE foggy W. latter part moderate gale from S.W. steering
N.E. S.W. & thick Rainy W

Monday April the 3rd
NE S.W. strong breeze from S.W. steering NE
N.E. E middle part squally with some Rain
latter part moderate gale & clear Weather steering NE
Mr Little off duty Lat 40-57 South
Long 54-22 West

Tuesday April the 4th
N.E. E S.W. Commences with a strong breeze from W.S.W. steering NE
under double reefed top sails middle & latter parts heavy
N.E. N.W. gale from N.E. under forest main & fore top
mast stay sail

Wednesday April the 5th
N.E. N.W. blowing whole gale from the northward & Westward
N N.W. middle part moderate & Rainy
N.E. N.W. latter part blowing heavy in squalls & Rain

Thursday April the 6th
N.E. N.W. the fore part blowing a heavy gale
heading N.E. middle part moderate gale & light
N.E. N.W. latter part strong breeze & clear Weather steering
Lat 39-30 South

Friday April the 7th Long 51-36 West
fore part strong breeze from the Westward steering
N.E. N sail in sight steering to the southward
S.W. middle & latter parts moderate breeze from S.W.
& heavy W
