Tuesday May the 23rd
NW by NE light breeze and fine weather all this
day Carpenter Employed making a new
mixer for top mast the old one rotten at the
shive hole Lat by obs 20-00N
Long by chron 52-30W

Wednesday May the 24th
NW by NE light breeze from ESE steering NW by W
sent down the old mixer for top mast & sent up
the new one Latter part gentle breeze from SE
furnished the cabin with a cow fish Lat 20-31N
Long by chron 53-24W

Thursday May the 25th
NW by W fresh breeze from the southward and
westward all the se 24 hours saw porpoises
the capt clinched one of the fore mast bands
and he clinched the capt the quarrel was
you let go of me Rayen let go of me

Friday May the 26th Long by chron 54-44W
NW by W This day moderate breeze and light squalls
of rain Employed at small jobs so ends

and squalls of rain so ends

Course Winds Sunday May the 28th

NW by SW Light variable winds and some thunder lightning
and rain one sail in sight steering to the southward
and middle part the same Latter part fine
breeze & pleasant weather Lat by obs 23-36N
Long by chron 56-51W

Monday May the 29th
NW by SW light breeze & fine weather
middle & latter parts variable winds attended
with thunder lightning and rain

Tuesday May the 30th
NW by SW fore part fresh breeze & Rainy weather
middle & latter parts fresh breeze & Rainy
squalls some thunder lightning & rain
Lat by obs 25-55N

Wednesday May the 31st Long by chron 59-53W
NW by SW Commences moderate breeze & sails in sight
steering to the southward middle part attended
with squalls of rain Latter part fine breeze
from SW & pleasant W all sail set
Lat by obs 26-28N

Thursday June the 1st Long by chron 61-02W
NW by SW light fine breeze & pleasant weather all
these 24 hours saw two sails steering to
the southward so ends Lat by obs 27-42N
Long by chron 62-45W

Friday June the 2nd
NW by SW All the se 24 hours fresh breeze from
the southward & westward & fine weather
saw a briggy steering South Lat 28-53N
Long by chron 64-39W

Saturday June the 3rd
NW by SW The fore part fresh breeze & clear weather
middle & latter parts light breeze and
squalls of rain some thunder & lightning
Lat by obs 29-35N
