Saturday Jan the 12th
fresh breeze from N to NE steering SE by E 3/4 E one sail in sight saw fin back
Lat 39° 05' S

Sunday Jan the 13th
fine part fresh breeze middle part fresh gale from NE to N steering E by S attended with Rain continued Rain

Monday Jan the 14th
saw fin back from part strong breeze from N middle & latter parts light breeze fine weather course E by S one sail in sight
Lat 38° 36' S

Tuesday Jan the 15th
fin back fresh breeze from NW steering E by S 2 sails in sight
Lat 38° 25' S

Wednesday Jan the 16th
A moderate breeze from NW steering E by S saw fin back
By compass spoke ship *Bea Ranger* of Boston bound to China
Lat 38° 01' S

Thursday Jan the 17th
fin back fresh breeze from NW steering E by S one sail in sight
Lat 37° 45' S

Friday Jan the 18th
fin back strong breeze from NW steering E by S caught a porpoise
Lat 37° 18' S

Saturday Jan the 19th
fin back fresh breeze middle parts fresh gale & squally from WSW caught a porpoise latter part moderate gale steering E by S
Lat 36° 57' S

Sunday Jan the 20th
fin back strong breeze from NW steering E by S some rain
Lat 36° 47' S

Monday Jan the 21st
fresh breeze from NW steering east saw nothing
William H. Kidrick & Portagee Inoab got Lat 36° 25' S
to fighting so the capt gave them a chance till they was satisfied

Tuesday Jan the 22nd
light breeze & fine W steering east pointed the main mast & mizen mast

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Barque *Srs Henrietta* bound to Swan River New Holland

Wednesday Jan the 23rd
steering East with light variable winds pointed the main mast & mizen mast
Lat 35° 54' S

Thursday Jan the 24th
light breeze from Westward steering east killed a hoggy
Lat 35° 25' S

Friday Jan the 25th
A strong breeze from the southward steering east some rain
Long 107° 54' E

Saturday Jan the 26th
steering east fresh gale from W to SW steering E by S
Lat 34° 01' S

Sunday Jan the 27th
A fresh breeze from the southward & Eastward steering E by S
Lat 32° 16' E

Monday Jan the 28th
strong breeze from southward at 5 PM saw the light were ship & stood off shore at 1 PM lashed & stood in at 5 PM saw the island of Kothness at 10 took a pilot & stood in for the harbor with a strong breeze so ends

Tuesday Jan the 29th
all sails fresh breeze from the southward at 1 PM came to anchor & the ship capt went on shore latter part all hands employed discharge cargo going frate such as hams nails cutlery box forks & spades tubs buckets tobacco & candles balances butter salmon & so forth
Wednesday Jan the 30th
latter part moderate gale steering E by S
all hands employed discharge frate got some potatoes
Draco & onions

Thursday Jan the 31st
English strong breeze employed at different jobs & discharged cargo good the cook sick

Friday Jan the 1st
fresh breeze from the southward employed at small jobs sent a letter home

Saturday February the 2nd
A fresh breeze from NW the capt on shore
