pilot left 50 fms.

A strong breeze from S.W. heading W some Rain
squalls one sail in sight Rotterdam in sight bearing S

Tuesday Feb the 5th

fin back strong breeze from the southward heading W.S.W.
but a new fore topgallant sail

Wednesday Feb the 6th

A strong breeze from S.E. heading S.W. & hazy weather

Thursday Feb the 7th

saw porpoises A moderate breeze from the southward all these 24 hours
Lat 36° 10' S

Friday Feb the 8th

saw fin A light breeze from the southward in different tacks
sacks one sail in sight saw porpoises & birds Lat 36° 41' S
Long 104° 23' E

Saturday Feb the 9th

and fresh breeze from N.E. steering S.E. by E saw killers
jumped the sail in sight Lat 37° 32'

Sunday Feb the 10th

saw fore part light breeze from N. steering S.E. by E & E
porpoises latter part fresh breeze from S.E. heading E.S.E. & sail in
sight

Monday Feb the 11th

saw A fresh gale from S.E. heading S.W. attended
porpoises with thick Rainy weather

A fresh gale from the southward & eastward steering
E by S & thick Rainy weather

boom & Blowing a fresh gale from W.S.W. steering E.S.E.
sail carried away a fore topmast studding sail boom

Long 129° 14' East
fresh water Steering E by S blowing a hole gale all these 24 hours
from W.S.W. & S.W.
