Barque *Henrietta* cruising for Whales the 22nd sh sea
Monday June the 22nd
All these 24 hours fresh breeze from S.W. to E.
Watch Employed hauling out blubber number of sails
in sight & some ice

Tuesday June the 23rd
fore & middle parts fresh breeze from S.E. clear weather
the main land in sight Employed bringing out 7
Hulls got through hauling latter part light breeze and
thick foggy all hands Employed stowing down

Wednesday June the 24th
Light variable wind S.E. foggy weather all these
24 hours Employed stowing down at 10 A.M.
got through cruising around the ice

Thursday June the 25th
A light breeze from S.W. to N.W. & fine weather
saw one whale toward 2 boats without success
gamed with the Milwood spoke Bangtucker
Employed scraping bone & other jobs & sundries

Friday June the 26th
light breeze & fine weather number of sails in sight
at 10 A.M. toward the boats & went in the ice chasing
for Whales saw number but didn't get any

Saturday June the 27th
boats A light breeze from the southward pleasant W.
cruising Whales in the ice & starboard boat
Whales struck & got stove killed him & took him along
side at 8 P.M. commenced cutting at 2 A.M. got
through at 10 A.M. commenced hauling sails in sight
Sunday June the 28th
A fresh breeze from the southward & clear weather
at 4 A.M. toward 3 boats & went in amongst the
ice looking for Whales at 10 came in foggy & the boats
came on board saw no Whales Employed hauling
five sails in sight

June 1856

Barque *Henrietta* Whaling in the ochotsk sea
Monday June the 23rd
fresh breeze from S.W. to S.E. & foggy wet weather
William at 10 A.M. gamed with the barn stable of *Waldford*
Godfrey capt fisher & capt *Wedge* of the ship *Mountain*
Reported her stove in the ice & sunk took 2 boys
from with us & got a top sail the watch Employed
Silvery hauling six sails in sight

Tuesday June the 24th
A fresh breeze from S. to S.E. & cloudy weather
at 10 A.M. got through hauling latter part
stowing ~~strong~~ breeze & thick foggy weather
Employed stowing down

Wednesday June the 25th
A fresh breeze from S.E. & foggy all these 24 hours
gamed with the young *Phoenix* of *Waldford*
capt *Wedge* fore part the watch Employed stowing
down & scraping bone & sundries

Thursday June the 26th
Fresh breeze from S.E. to S.W. foggy & some rain
four sails in sight latter part gamed with the
Barn stable

Friday June the 27th
A moderate breeze from S. to E. S.E. & thick
foggy weather all these 24 hours saw five sails

Saturday June the 28th
Fore part light breeze from S.E. & foggy weather
gamed with the ship *Sarah* of *Waldford*
latter part attended with thick rainy weather and
fresh breeze

Sunday June the 29th
A fresh breeze from E. S.E. & clear weather
attended with thick rainy weather all these
24 hours bore the led 65 fathoms water green
mud bottom
