third mate one boat steerer four fore mast

Friday Nov the 21st

Employed at various jobs shipped fourth mate

Saturday Nov the 22nd

Employed getting off water & stowing it down

Sunday Nov the 23rd

Went to beach from the southward some rain
I have been on shore today saw nothing looked
like home

Monday Nov the 24th

Employed getting off water & stowing it down

Tuesday Nov the 25th

Employed getting off water & stowing it down
the ship Nautilus undertook to go out side
but she went ashore on the Reef and was
lost blowing & heavy gale & dragged from the
southward

Wednesday Nov the 26th

This day Employed at various jobs

Thursday Nov the 27th

Employed setting up the main & misen
tacking I have been to Surcouf to night

Friday Nov the 28th

Employed setting up rigging & taking in

potatoes pumpkins onions & so forth at
10 o'clock commenced on moving ship and
got keddy for sea

Saturday Nov the 29th

Light breeze from ENE at 3 P.M. the tug boat
took us out side made all sail & layed
off. Bon latter part Employed at various jobs

Sunday Nov the 30th

Light variable winds laying off. Bon number
of sails in sight

Monday ^{December} the 1st

Light breeze from NE laying off. Bon
Employed at various jobs number of sails in sight

Tuesday December the 2nd

Light airs & calm some rain laying off. Bon
Waiting for the capt & his wife & boy

Wednesday Dec the 3rd

The fore part light breeze from NE & heavy W
middle part light airs & calm attended with rain
Latter part fresh breeze in squalls & thick
rainy weather laying off. Bon for the capt

Thursday Dec the 4th

Moderate variable breeze & rain showers
laying off. Bon number of sails in sight
caught all the Runaways but one Samuel being
at 12 at noon the capt & his wife & baby came
on board

Friday Dec the 5th

Fresh breeze from E to NE & steering SSE
one sail in sight the Watch Employed at
various jobs
