A fine breeze from S.W. &
 pleasant weather two sails
 in sight at 1 P.M. took the
 two whales along side and
 commenced cutting. at 4¹/₂ got
 through saw whales lowered
 the boats without success
 middle & latter parts steering
 N.W. to E. ends the day

Friday April the 23rd
 A moderate breeze from S. to
 S.W. steering N.W. some
 foggy squalls two sails in sight
 at 6 A.M. commenced hailing

Saturday April the 24th
 The fore & middle parts fresh
 breeze from S. to S.W.
 steering N.W. by N. at 10
 P.M. got through hailing
 latter part strong breeze
 from S.W. to W. attended
 with Rain squalls

Sunday April the 25th

The fore part strong breeze
 from S.W. to S. steering N.W.
 middle part breeze from N.E.
 & struggled under double reefed top sails
 latter part fresh breeze from
 E. to S.E. steering N.W. the
 weather clear & cool

Light variable winds from
 the Southward & Westward
 steering N.W. by N. one sail
 in sight employed making Spungum

Sunday April the 18th

The fore & middle parts light
 variable winds & calm some Rain
 squalls latter part fresh
 breeze from N.E. steering N.W. by N.

The fore part moderate breeze
 from N.E. steering N.W. by N.
 middle & latter parts light breeze
 from N.E. to N.W. heading
 N.W. to W. the weather fine

A moderate breeze from N.E.
 to N.W. heading N.W. steering
 N.W. by N. saw two sails & porpoises
 prepared the spanker

A moderate breeze from
 to S.W. steering N.W. by W.
 at 10 A.M. saw two whales
 lowered the two boats to Starboard
 boat three times without
 success larboard boat struck
 & killed four whales & saved two
 one sail in sight
