A fine breeze from E to ESE
pleasant weather steering
NW by N employed starting
break water one sail in sight

Tuesday April the 13th
A fresh breeze from NE to
ESE steering NW by N one
sail in sight
mistle & batter parts attended
with thunder lightning and
rain in squalls one sail in
sight bark 500 strokes so ends
1858 58:10

Wednesday April the 14th
Lynish trade winds from E
to NE steering NW by N
NW some rain squalls
at 6 PM saw a school of
small spin whales
going to the westward and
two boats without success
one sail in sight
21:00 59:50

Thursday April the 15th
A moderate breeze from ENE
to SE steering NW by N employed
cleaning the deck
22:17 60:56

Friday April the 16th
A light breeze from SE to S
steering NW by N & NW by N
employed repairing the main
top sail & making a run yarn
Lat 24:45 N Long 61:37 W

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Tuesday April the 6th 1858
Strong trade winds from NE
to ENE steering NW
employed taring down the
fore & main rigging
5:48 42:54

Wednesday April the 7th
Strong trade winds varying from
NE to E steering NW some light
showers of rain painted the fore
yard ships bark 7000 strokes
7:48 45:34

Thursday April the 8th
Strong trades from NE to E
steering NW painted the
main yard
9:29 47:47

Friday April the 9th
Strong trade winds from NE
to E steering NE all sail set
bark as before
11:38 51:25

Saturday April the 10th
A strong breeze from ENE
to E steering NW all sail
set some light rain squalls
13:34 52:42

Sunday April the 11th
A strong breeze from E to ESE
steering NW all sail set
struck a porpoise & lost him
15:22 54:39
