at 8 AM attended with thunder
lightning & rain in squalls
one sail in sight

A strong breeze from W to SSW
B. Squally steering NE by N at 8 AM
one sail in sight leak 7000 S

Monday March the 15th
A strong breeze from S to SE
at 8 AM steering NE by N at 8 AM
all sail set

Tuesday March the 16th
A strong breeze from SW
steering NE by N at 8 AM
middle & latter parts squally
from S to NE attended
with lightning & rain
ships leak 6000 strokes

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Lat 33 Long 42-55

Saturday March the 6th 1858
The fore part light airs from SW
steering NE by N at 8 AM
middle & latter parts fresh breeze
from NE heading NNW saw a grampus

A strong breeze from the Northward
at 8 AM on various tacks one sail
in sight wet hole

A fresh breeze from NNE heading
E middle & latter parts strong

Tuesday March the 9th
A strong breeze from S to SE
steering NE by N at 8 AM
in showers one sail in sight

A moderate breeze from SE to SW
