

Ship *Waverly* of N.B. Homeward Bound February 1858
Lat Long

Thursday Feb the 18th 1858
All these 24 hours strong breeze
from the Northward & Westward
Steering N by E & attended with
thick rainy weather one sail in sight
saw porpoises leach 4500 strokes

Friday Feb the 19th
The fore & middle parts strong
breeze from W to NW steering
E by N latter part moderate breeze
from N by E hazy weather one sail
in sight set fore top gallant
studling sail 56:58 72:56

Saturday Feb the 20th
Commenced fresh breeze from
the Northward & Eastward heading
to the Southward & Eastward
middle part fair one sail in
sight Leach 4000 strokes

Sunday Feb the 21st
The fore & middle parts strong breeze
from NW to W steering N by E saw a Whirl
latter part light breeze from the Whirl
Southward two sails in sight 54:49 68:17

Monday Feb the 22nd
The fore & middle parts fresh
variable winds & thick cold rain
squalls two sails in sight
latter part strong breeze from
SW steering N by E one sail in
sight leach 6000 strokes

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Saturday Feb the 13th 1858
The fore part calm & thick fog
middle & latter parts strong breeze
from S steering E by N same
rain squalls saw porpoises Lat Long 54:48

Sunday Feb the 14th
A strong breeze from S to SSW
steering E by N & E by N same rain
squalls the weather cold
leach 7000 strokes

Monday Feb the 15th
The fore part strong breeze from
S steering E by N
middle & latter parts light
breeze from the westward
steering E leach 5000 strokes 74:56

Tuesday Feb the 16th
The fore part strong breeze from
NW steering E saw lots of porpoises
middle part fresh gale and rain
latter part moderate gale from
W steering E by N
leach the same as before 55:52 84:47

Wednesday Feb the 17th
Blowing a strong breeze from
NW to W all day 24 hours
steering E by N & E by N one sail in
sight steering the same saw
lots of porpoises leach 6000 strokes
Lat by only 56:23
