breeze from WSW to WNW
steering E S E by S some sail
in sight steering to the northward

Sunday Jan the 31st
The fore part light breeze from WNW
steering E middle part light breeze
from N to N E
Latter part fresh breeze from N E
steering E by S E attended with
thick rainy weather leak 200 strokes

Monday February the 1st 1858
The fore part strong breeze from N
steering E by S under double reefed
top sails middle & latter parts
moderate breeze from N W to W
steering E by S attended with rain
leak 3000 strokes

Tuesday Feb the 2nd
Strong breeze from the westward
all these 24 hours steering E by S
Some rain squalls saw porpoises
leak 500 strokes

Monday January the 25th 1858
A strong breeze from WNW to
WSW steering E by S by
compass at 10 minutes to 4
P.M. I had some difficulty
with one of the stowaway sat
the wheel I struck him five
times with my hand for his
insolence about steering the ship
his name was George.

Tuesday Jan the 26th
The fore part fresh breeze from
WSW steering E by S sent the
lower standing sail
middle & latter parts light
breeze & a heavy swell on from
SW ship's leak 400 strokes

Wednesday Jan the 27th
The fore part light breeze from
WNW steering E by S all sail set
middle part fresh breeze from
N N E & rain
Latter part moderate gale from
N N W steering E S E the
weather thick & rainy under
double reefed top sails & courses

Thursday Jan the 28th
All these 24 hours fresh
gale from N W to W steering
E by N to E S E attended with
rain in squalls pumped
6000 strokes water on deck
all the time
