Mon 23 Employed breaking out oil and
coopering it Mr Quinn sick
with the huku fever

Tue 24 Employed breaking out oil & carried
23 cask on board the ship Capt Gosnold
Mr Quinn rather better 28 gallons of
oil sold

Wed 25 Employed skimming oil on board
of the barthomew Gosnold put on
board 55 casks in all

Thurs 26 Employed at various jobs I have been
on shore to day to get my discharge

Fri 27 It has been very warm today
I have been on shore to day to get
my discharge in sub Capt Caswell
& number of my old friends

Sat 28 I have been on shore to day to
look for a chance to get home

Sun 29 it has been a lonesome day to day
for me I have been busy packing
up my things & getting ready for
home I wish I was at home with
my wife & little daughter I know
it would not be so lonesome

Mon 30 I have been on shore to day to
look for a chance to get home

B & H at anchor in Honolulu Harbor Nov
Sanitary Nov the 13th 1857

Fri 13 Employed discharging oil the ship
Indy capt Long came in today
three thousand barrels this season

Sat 14 Employed discharging oil & storing
the ground cask in the main
hatch way

Sun 15 Light trade winds today & warm
most all hands has gone ashore

Mon 16 Employed discharging oil

Tues 17 Employed discharging oil - sold
29 gallons of oil

Wed 18 Employed discharging oil

Thurs 19 Employed discharging oil & storing
the ground cask

Fri 20 Employed discharging oil and
storing ground cask Received two
letters today

Sat 21 Employed moving ship & piling
the ground casks with sawdust
Water put 14 79 barrels of oil aboard the ship
Magnolia capt C. on for sale at 4 cents per gal

Sun 22 fresh trade winds & fine rain
I have been on shore to day
but saw nothing that looked
like home
