Whaling between the shore & the light staff
Tuesday September 1st 1854

Tues 1 A light breeze from W to NW &
fine weather Employed hauling
& stowing down two sails
in sight

Wed 2 Light variable winds & calm
Employed hauling & chasing
Whales light sails in sight

Thurs 3 A moderate breeze from NW
to N & fine weather Employed
hauling & stowing down and
chasing Whales

Fri 4 A fresh breeze from NW to N
& hazy weather Employed stow-
ing down & chasing Whales
same sails in sight

Sat 5 The fore & middle parts strong
breeze from NW & B. Rainy weather
Employed stowing down
Latter part moderate gale
& Rainy steering for the light staff
harbor six sails in sight

Sun 6 A fresh gale from NW and
Rainy at 4 P.M. came to
anchor in the light staff harbor
12 ships in the harbor
Latter part Employed stowing
down the weather moderate

1854

Whaling between the shore & the light staff
Thursday Aug the 27th 1854

Thurs 27 The fore & middle parts light
air & calm Employed stowing
down Latter part fresh breeze
from SW Employed hauling
close to the shore

Fri 28 A strong breeze in squalls
from NW to SW Employed
hauling stowing down &
chasing Whales

Sat 29 A fresh breeze from NW
to SW & hazy weather
Employed hauling for
boats chasing Whales S.B.B.
struck killed & took him
along side at 4 P.M. &
cut him in in the night
four sails in sight

Sun 30 A strong breeze from SW
to NW & Employed hauling
saw one whale three sails
in sight

Mon 31 A fresh breeze from NW to SW
Employed hauling at 5 P.M.
gamed with the ship
Bar the well
Latter part three boats
chasing Whales the st
boat struck killed him
took him along side
& cut him in the st
boat stove
