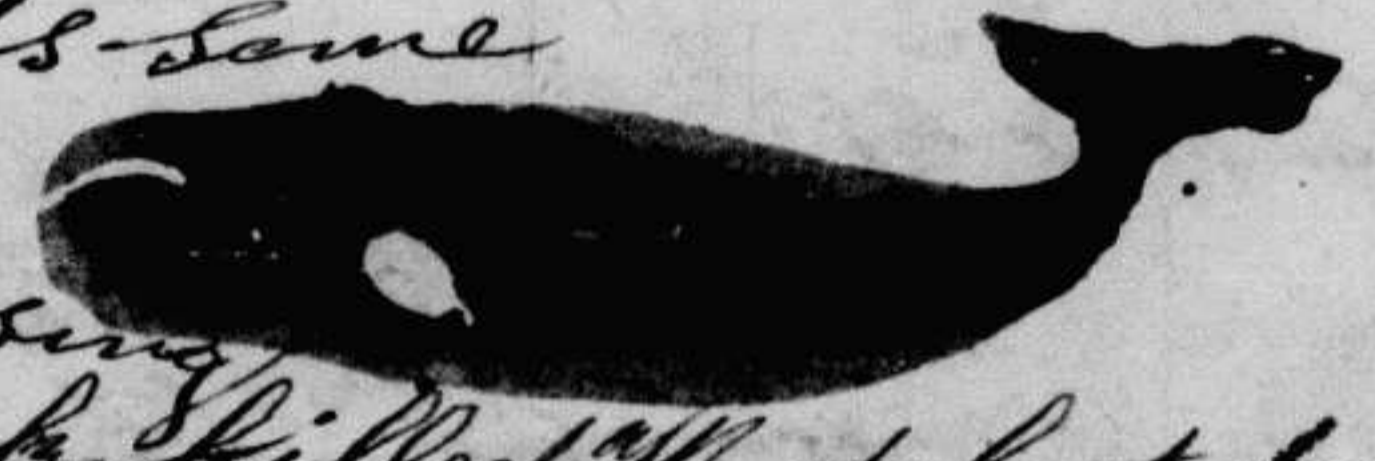


B. H. L. Whaling in S.W. Gulf August 1854

Thursday Aug the 13th 1854
Light variable winds - some
thunder lightning & rain the boats chasing
Whales S.B.B. struck killed Mast boat when
lazed by him all night till 8 AM mist good
at 11 AM towed him along
side & cut him in the ship
keepers employed hauling



Friday 14 A light breeze & calm all the
boats chasing Whales
boat struck killed & anchored
him at 10 AM took him along
side & cut him in broke Frank
Claryton & took Manuel the
Spaniard for boat steerer in the
Mast boat



Sat 15 A fresh breeze from N.E. and
foggy some thunder lightning
& rain employed hauling the
boats chasing Whales without
success

Sun 16 A fresh breeze from W to S.W.
Employed hauling three boats
chasing Whales without success
the capt went off again aboard the ship
the first was gone all night

Mon 17 Light air & calm at 9 AM the capt
came on board from shore brought
some salmon & a train deer employed
stowing down at 9 AM got
underway & steered to the N.E. between the
ten pin & North shore

Friday August the 7th 1854
Light variable winds & clear weather
two boats chasing whales at 4
PM took the whale along side
& cut him in employed hauling

Sat 8 A fresh breeze from S.W.
four boats chasing whales
employed hauling lots of
ships in sight

Sun 9 Light variable winds
the boats chasing Whales
S.B.B. struck killed
him & two boats took
him in tow lazed by him
all night



Mon 10 A fresh breeze from S.W.
at 3 PM took the whale
along side & commenced cutting
latter part employed stowing
down & the boats chasing Whales

Tues 11 A light breeze from S.W.
all the boats chasing Whales
saw plenty going quick

Wed 12 A light breeze from N.E.
some foggy the boats chasing
Whales S.B.B. struck
killed him at 7 AM
took him along side &
cut him in
