B & H Whaling in amuckst the ice
Monday June the 3rd 1854

Mon 3 Light variable winds & some foggy
gamed with the ship California
in the ice Middle & latter parts
fine clear weather gamed the
ship Lagoda 12 sails in sight

Tues 4 Light breeze from the
Southward & fine weather
gaming with the ship
Lagoda capt Wiland & Vinyard
capt Casuel got three cash
of bread from the Vinyard
& ten bls of beef from the
Lagoda twelve sails in sight
Middle & latter parts moderate
breeze & foggy weather

Wed 10 A fresh breeze from the Southward
& Eastward on various tacks in
the ice the weather foggy twelve
sails in sight turned the cook out of the
gally & put portagee in his place

Thurs 11 A light breeze & some foggy
& fair number of sails in
in sight gamed with the
Linos of Saghahier & spoke the
Savak at 11^o had some difficulty
With Rufeer a black portagee i
struck him five or six times for
his insolence at the wheel
coursing in the ice looking for
Whales without success so ends

B & H looking for Whales along the ice June
Thursday June the 4th 1854

Thurs 4 The fore part fresh breeze from
N.E. & steering to the Southward
along the ice Middle part
steering N.N.W.
Latter part strong breeze
steering to the Southward and
Westward four sails in sight
spoke large & fine of cold
spring capt Tenney sailing

Fri 5 A strong gale from S.E. and
cloudy weather tacking around
in the ice Middle part some
fair squalls
Latter part strong breeze
& thick foggy weather by spells
lots of sails in sight & ice
but no Whales

Sat 6 A fresh breeze from S.E. &
& foggy weather on various
tacks in the ice number of sails
in sight gamed with the
hann stable at 11^o H. M. saw
two Whales toward the boats
without success.

Sun 7 A light breeze from S.E.
some foggy four boats chasing
Whales without success
Middle & latter parts light
airs & calm two sails in sight
& heavy ice all around
