Tues 14 A strong breeze from N^E to S^W steering N^W by N Employed overhauling the potatoes - onions found very few rotten potatoes but plenty rotten onions - lashed the cutting penents over 50 Cuds

Wednes 15 A strong breeze from S^W steering N^W by N Employed at various jobs

Thurs 16 The fore part strong breeze from S^W steering N^W by N Middle & latter parts Moderate gale from S to E & thick Rainy Weather carried away a fore top mast studding sail boom

Fri 17 The fore & Middle parts fresh gale from E to N steering N^W by N & thick Rainy Weather Latter part strong breeze from N^W by N heading W Reared the fore top mast stay sail

Sat 18 Fore part fresh breeze from N^W by N heading W Middle part calm Latter part fresh breeze from S steering N^W Made a top mast studding sail boom

Sun 19 Fore part strong breeze from S^W by S steering N^W some Rain Middle & latter parts strong breeze from S^W to N^W heading N^E wore ship & headed W saw fin backs

Tuesday April the 14 1857

Tues 14 A fresh breeze from N^E to S^W steering N^W Employed painting boats & other jobs

Wednes 15 Light variable Wind S^W calm steering N^W Employed at various jobs

Thurs 16 A light breeze from S^E to S steering N^W Employed painting boats & other jobs

Fri 17 Fore part light breeze from S steering N^W Middle part calm latter part fresh breeze from N heading W & W saw porpoises

Sat 18 The fore part fresh breeze from N^E steering N^W Middle & latter parts light breeze from N^E to S^E some Rain squalls

Sun 19 All these 24 hours light variable Winds some Rain steering N^W

Mon 20 The fore part light variable Winds & some Rain Middle & latter parts Moderate gale from N^W by N steering N^W Employed at various jobs saw cow fish
