Sat 14 At 4 PM Capt Butlers three daughters came on board and took tea at Capt's ashore again
Latter part employed clearing the anchors & other jobs

Sun 15 The fore & middle parts thick
Rainy weather at 10 AM the Capt his Wife & boy came on board at 11 got underway with a fine breeze from SW & stood out of the harbor

Sun 1 The fore & middle parts light after ships in port
Winds steering towards Wungana two brothers at 10 AM came to anchor and
banded the sails (New England Barque Warren
Jiroh swift

Mon 2 Still hands employed at various jobs
Ship Mary of Edger town came in to day & the ship Jiroh swift went to sea homeward bound

Tues 3 Still hands employed looking out and various other jobs

Wednes 4 All hands employed getting off Water & storing it down

Thurs 5 All hands employed getting off Wood & Water & storing it down
carried ashore 527 gallons of barrel oil & sold it

Fri 6 All hands employed storing down Wood & Water

Satur 7 Fore part employed washing wetting Van
ship in side & out
Latter part painting ship Caroline & B in side
ship massach
tucket & ship

Sun 8 Starboard Watch ashore on liberty
I have been on shore this afternoon & took tea at Capt Butlers they are a very nice family
